First part Moderate Breeze from the North
steering by to the N. W. all sail set the first
time for a month. Barometer 30 3/10
Later part a Gale from the North steering S. W. at
10 A.M. Close Reefed main top sail. took fore and
main top sails and fore sail and have too on
the fore tack. raining hard. Barometer 29 3/10

Remarks Saturday Jan 20th 207th Day.
Begins with a Gale from the North and rain.
have too on the fore tack. Barometer 29 3/10
and still falling. turned up the S. Boat.
every appearance of a heavy Gale. Middle and later
part a heavy Gale. at midnight the wind shifted
to the Westward. Lat 41-22

Remarks Sunday Jan 21st 208th Day.
Begins with a Gale of wind from the
Westward. going too under Close Reefed
main top sail. heading N. W. at 1 P.M.
began to moderate. at 5 the wind shifted
to the S. W. Barometer 29 3/4 Later part
strong winds from N. W. heading to the Westward
under Double Reef. Lat 40-54 Long 29-39

Remarks Monday Jan 22nd 209th Day.
Begins with strong winds from N. W. came S. at
5 P.M. heaved too. took fore & main top sails
later part Calm and foggy. Lat 42-00 Long 30-00
