First part - light breeze from N.W. and
fine. Spoke the Steamer Henrietta of
Lancaster from River Platte bound to San
Francisco. At 5 P.M. commenced Bailing.
Latter part - calms and light air. No Sun.
Barometer 30 4/10

Remarks Wednesday June 27th 365th Day.
First part - light air and calms.
At 11 P.M. finished Bailing the whole
turned up 28 bbls. Latter part fine. Saw
Bin & Back. Lat 40-50 Long 57-58
Bar 30-40

Remarks Thursday June 28th 366th Day
First part - pleasant breeze from N.W.
and fine. Saw Bin & Back. Latter part
Moderate and cloudy. No Obs. Bar 30-40

Remarks Friday June 29th 367th Day.
First part - Moderate breeze from S.W.
and cloudy. Latter part Calm. At 8 A.M.
Drake Out to Stow Oil in the main hold.
found the Oil black. Took On Deck
and Coopered it. Barometer 30 4/10
Lat 39-35

Remarks Saturday June 30th 368th Day
First part - Calm. Employed Coopering Oil.
At 4 P.M. finished Coopering and Stowing the
brounce. A light breeze from North.
Latter part strong breeze from the North
and thick. Employed Stowing Oil.
Barometer 30-34 Lat 40-12

Remarks Sunday July 1st 1866. 369th Day
Begins with strong winds North. Securing
S. & S. at 6 P.M. wore ship and stowed
S.W. at 5 finished Stowing Oil. Stowed
40 Bbls whole Oil. Latter part fresh
breeze and thick weather. Barometer 29 5/10

Remarks Monday July 2nd 370th Day.
Begins with fresh breeze from the North
relating to the eastward. Barometer 29 5/10
Thermometer 46 - Latter part fresh breeze
from N.W. and thick. Barometer 29 5/10
Lat 40-04

Remarks Tuesday July 3rd 371st Day.
Begins with fresh breeze from N.W.
and thick. Saw a ship steering to the
South. Barometer 29 5/10 Latter part -
strong winds and rain. Under double Reef.
at 11 A.M. took in fore and main topsails.
Barometer 29 5/10 No Obs.

Remarks Wednesday July 4th 372nd Day
First part - a Gale from the N.W. have
too under a close reefed main top sail. Had
to the N.E. You may think that I do not
think of home as I have never written
about it since in St. Catharines. But I never
thought more of it. But I am scolding my
self for future events. Latter part a Gale
from the W. we had roast Turkey for
dinner. You at home have got
lamb and peas. I wish I could
get some Oil. we can see no chance
I do not know what we shall
do if we do not get some soon.
