Remarks Friday July 6th 374
Begins with moderate breeze from N.
with a heavy southerly swell. Saw Killers.
Latter part strong breeze from the west under double
top sail. Barometer 29 3/10 Lat 38-37 Long 55-46

Remarks Saturday July 7th 375th
Begins with strong winds from the N.W. under
double reef. Latter part light. Barometer 30 1/10
Lat 37-54 Long 55-38

Remarks Sunday July 8th 376th Day.
Begins with light air and calms. Bar 30 3/10
Latter part moderate breeze from S.W. heading
to the N. Barometer 29 4/10 Lat 38-14 Long 55-58

Remarks Monday July 9th 377th
Begins with moderate breeze from E. steering
to the south. Barometer 30 3/10 Latter part a gale
from N.W. steering N.W. under double reef. At noon took
in the fore and main topsails and buffed too Bar 29 3/10
Lat 40-20 Long

Remarks Tuesday July 10th 378
Begins with a gale from the North. Have
not under close reef Main Topsail. At 8 P.M.
the wind heaved to the westward in a tempest.
Latter part strong winds. Saw Bin & Backs
Barometer 29 3/10
Lat 40-55 Long 56-33

swell. Bar 30 3/10 Latter part moderate.
53 fathoms Lat 39-59 Long 57-09

Remarks Friday July 13th 381st
First part light air and calms. Bar 30 3/10
Latter part fresh breeze from the North and thick
steering S.W. Saw a dark steering to the S.W. Bar 30 3/10

Remarks Saturday July 14th 382nd
First part fresh breeze from N.W. head
to the westward under double reef. Bar 30 3/10
Latter part moderate. heading to the westward
45 fathoms water. Lat 41-09 Long 58-31

Remarks Sunday July 15th 383rd
First part moderate winds from N. heading N.W.
saw Bin & Back and N.W. Back. at night
shortened sail. Since Dist 120 miles. By Oct.
at 8 took in fore and main topsails and were to the eastward.
Latter part thick fog. Bar 30. Lat 41-18 Long 59-32

Remarks Monday July 16th 384th
First part fresh breeze from the N.W.
and foggy. Head East. under double reef Main
Top. Set 1st & 2nd sail. Bar 29 3/10 Latter part calms
and foggy. Lat 41-35 Long 59-29

Remarks Tuesday July 17th 385th
First part moderate breeze from N.W. Bar 29 3/10
Latter part moderate from N.W.
Saw Bin & Backs
Lat 41-11 Long 59-45
