Remarks Thursday Sept 27th 1866. 457
Begins with fresh breezes from the westward
course N by W. All Sail Set. Barometer 29.75
Thermometer 41. Latter part fresh breeze W N W.
Steering to the North. Employed fitting Boats.

Lat 45=36 Long 76=47
Remarks Friday Sept 28th 458th
Begins with fresh breezes from NW steering by to the
North. At 4 P.M. Double Reefed. Barometer 30.70
Thermometer 46. Latter part fresh breezes from the
westward steering to the Northward.

Lat 43=25 Long 76=47
Remarks Saturday Sept 29th 459th
Begins with fresh breezes from the westward
steering N N E. Employed fitting Boats. At 4 P.M.
put the L and W Boats on the Cranes. At 6 P.M.
luffed to and shortened Sail On Chili. Barometer 30.70
Latter part fresh breezes from NW heading by to
the N N E. Saw Bin Back. Lat 42=20 Long 76=38

Remarks Sunday Sept 30th 460th
Begins with moderate breezes from NW heading by to
the N N E. at 4 P.M. wore ship to the NW.
Latter part strong winds from the W N W and a heavy
S.W. swell. Heading SW under double reefed top sails
Barometer 30 Thermometer 48. No Obs.

Remarks Monday Oct 1st 461
Begins with strong winds W N W and thick
weather heading SW. at 4 P.M. wore the North.
Latter part a Gale from N N W. Hove too under
a double reefed main top sail. Barometer 29.75
Lat 42=47 No Obs

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Remarks Tuesday Oct 2nd 1866. 462nd
Begins with a Gale from N N W hove too
under close reefed main top sail head to the west.
heavy squalls of rain. at 6 P.M. the wind hauled
to the South in a squall. made an awful sea.
the ship shipped a sea and started two boats
bearers and broke one crane and started the
beers over head. wore ship and got her
head to the sea. and she then lay very well
except wallowing some. Latter part light
breezes from SE and heavy swell. steering NW.
Employed repairing damages.

Lat 42=25 No Obs.
Remarks Wednesday Oct 3rd 463rd
Begins with light breezes from SE and rain
steering NW. Latter part moderate breezes from
W N W course N N W. Barometer 30.70. Employed
repairing the 83 boat. Lat 40=43 Long 76=57

Remarks Thursday Oct 4th 464th
Begins with moderate breezes from W N W
course N N W. Employed repairing the 83 boat.
Latter part moderate. repairing boat. Barometer 30.70
Lat 39=41 Long 76=11

Remarks Friday Oct 5th 465th
Begins with moderate breezes from W N W. course
N N E. finished the boat. at sun down shortened
tail and luffed too. Barometer 30.70. Thermometer 52.
Latter part strong winds from NW heading N N E.
under double reef. Saw Bin Back Lat 38=49 No Obs.

Remarks Saturday Oct 6th 466th
Begins with strong winds from NW. increasing to a Gale.
at 6 have too under close reefed main top sail. rain.
Barometer 30.70 At midnight the wind hauled to
the South. wore ship to the west. Latter part steering
N E under close reefed main top sail and 3 sail. Lat 38=39 Long 76=11
