Sail. At 2 P.M. raised the Island of Mocha
bearing by compass N.E. 1/2 E. Dist 25 Miles. At
4 P.M. wore ship to the W. S.W. saw Ben's Backs.
at Sun down took in the Fore sail. Latter strong
winds from the South. heading W. S.W. under Double Reefs.
Barometer 30 1/4 Lat 38-08 Long 73-12

Remarks Monday Oct. 8th. 468th.
Begins with strong breezes from the South. heading
S. to the W. S.W. under double Reefs. at Sun down took
in the Fore and Mizen Top sails and wore to the East.
Latter part strong southerly winds. heading by to the
eastward under double Reefs. reefed the Old Main
Top Sail and Spanker up for patches. Barometer 30 3/4

Begins with strong southerly winds heading

Begins with strong winds from the S. under
double reefed Top Sails. Latter part more
moderate. Employed repairing the Fore Top Sail.

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Remarks Thursday Oct. 12th 1866. 472nd.
Begins with fresh breezes from the South.
Employed repairing the Fore Top Sail.
Latter part fresh Gale from S.E. heading S.W.
under Double reefed Main Top Sail and Fore sail.

Remarks Friday Oct. 13th. 473rd
Begins with a Gale from the S.E. have too
head to the S.W. under Double Main Top Sail and
Fore sail. Barometer 30 1/4 Latter part a Gale
from S.E. have too head to the East. under double
reefed Main Top Sail. Lat 37-37 Long 76-02

Remarks Saturday Oct. 14th. 474th
Begins with a moderate Gale from S.E. heading
East under Double reefed Main Top Sail at 6 P.M.
the hauls a little to the Westward and moderate.

Remarks Sunday Oct. 15th. 475th.
Begins with light breezes from S.E. and boggys.
heading S.W. Barometer 30 3/4
Latter part calm. Employed repairing the Fore Top Sail.

Remarks Tuesday Oct. 16th 476th
Begins with moderate breezes from W. Course
S.W. by E. saw two Ben's Backs. Latter part winds
from the North and increasing. Employed repairing P. Sail.
had to put in the penn on account of rain. Course S.E.
Barometer 29 3/4 Lat 37-38 Long 76-15

Remarks Wednesday Oct. 17th. 477th.
Begins with moderate Gale from N.W. Course S. rain.
at 4 P.M. hauled to the W. cleared off and moderate made
Sail. Barometer 29 3/4 Latter part strong winds from
the West. finished and bent the Fore Top Sail.
