Remarks Saturday Nov 17th 1866. 508
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W.
at 7 P.M. Huao bearing E by compass Dist 30
miles. heading to the N.W. Latter part light airs
from W.S.W. employed repairing the masts & bulwarks.
Barometer 30.500. Saw No Backs. Lat 23-0.

Remarks Sunday Nov 18th 509th
Begins with moderate breezes from N.W. Saw
No Backs. at 7 P.M. Huao bearing E by S Dist 30
miles. heading to the westward. Middle and latter
a rising N.W. then. at 10 P.M. the wind hauled
to the S.W. and cleared off. Barometer 29.90
Lat 23-22

Remarks Monday Nov 19th 510th
Begins with strong winds from S.W. by S.
under double reefed main top sail and fore sail.
at 7 P.M. Huao bearing E by S Dist 20 miles
heading W by N. Latter part moderate breezes
from the south. Saw No Backs.

Remarks Tuesday Nov 20th 511th
Begins with light breezes from the S.W. Saw
No Backs. Make the land. Latter part
moderate breezes from W.S.W. and thick weather.
at noon Huao bearing E Dist 25 miles.
Lat 23-10

Remarks Wednesday Nov 21st 512th
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. and thick
weather. at 7 P.M. Huao bearing E Dist 15 miles.
Latter part moderate and thick. Lat 23-20

Remarks Thursday Nov 22nd 513th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. and
thick and a heavy swell. Latter part calm.
Huao bearing E by S Dist 35 miles.
Lat 23-06

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Remarks Friday Nov 23rd 1866. 514th
Begins with pleasant breezes from S.W. Saw
No Backs. at 7 P.M. Huao bearing E by S.
Dist 30 miles heading to the westward. Bar. 29.90
Latter part fresh breezes from W.S.W.

Remarks Saturday Nov 24th 515th
Begins with fresh breezes from W.S.W. and a
heavy swell. under double reef. at 7 P.M. Huao
bearing E by S Dist 25 miles. heading N.W. by N.
Latter part strong winds from the westward and
squally. Barometer 29.90 Lat 23-33

Remarks Sunday Nov 25th 516th
Begins with strong winds from the westward
under double reef. Latter part a Gale and thick
under double reefed main top sail and fore
sail. heading S.W. Barometer 29.80 at 8 P.M.
Saw the land bearing E Dist 25 miles.

Remarks Monday Nov 26th 517th
Begins with a Gale from the W. heading to the
S.W. at 5 P.M. wore ship to the N.W. Moderate
S.W. the fore top sail close reefed. Latter part
heavy westerly winds. under close reefs.

Remarks Tuesday Nov 27th 518th
Begins with strong westerly winds and
squally. under close reefs. Bar. 29.90
Latter part the same. Long 13-03 Long 15-42

Remarks Wednesday Nov 28th 519th
Begins with strong westerly winds. under close
reefs. Barometer 29.80. Latter part the
same continued.
Lat 23-07 Long 16-00
