Remarks Thursday Nov 27th 1866. 520th
Begins with strong westerly winds under close
reefed top sails. Barometer 29⁷⁵/₁₀₀
Later part strong winds and rainy Barometer 29⁹⁰/₁₀₀

Remarks Friday Nov 30th 521st
Begins with a moderate Gale from S.W. and raining
at 4 P.M. wind hauled to S.W. under double reefed
main top sail and fore sail. Barometer 29⁸⁵/₁₀₀
Later part - moderate all sails set. Barometer 30²⁵/₁₀₀

Lat 42-46 Long 75-47
Remarks Saturday Dec 1st 522nd
Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. and
a heavy swell. at 4 P.M. the backed to the
westward and began to breeze on. Double reefed
the top sails. Barometer 30⁷⁰/₁₀₀ Middle part a Gale
from the W. under a double reefed main top sail. Last
part moderate. Set double reefs. Lat 43-22 Long 75-55

Remarks Sunday Dec 2nd 523rd
Begins with fresh breezes from the westward
and thick weather. Barometer 30⁷⁰/₁₀₀ Ch. 118
Middle and later parts a Gale from W to S.W.
have too under a double reefed main top sail and
fore sail. Barometer 29⁹⁰/₁₀₀ Lat 43-27 Long 76-04

Remarks Monday Dec 3rd 524th
Begins with a Gale from S.W. have too head
to the westward under double reefed main top sail
and reefed fore sail. Barometer 29²⁵/₁₀₀ Ch. 47
Later part - more moderate, under double reef.

Lat 42-43 Long 76-24
Remarks Tuesday Dec 4th 525th
Begins with moderate breezes from the westward and
thick weather. Later part rainy.
Lat 43-25 Long 76-16

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Remarks Wednesday Dec 5th 1866. 526th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. and thick
weather heading S.E. under double reef. Barometer 29⁹⁰/₁₀₀
Later part fresh breezes from S.W. Saw a Whaling
Bark. at 7 A.M. saw Huape. at noon bearing N by E
Dist 25 miles. Lat 43-49 Long 75-24

Remarks Thursday Dec 6th 527th
Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. and rough.
at 9 P.M. Huape bearing E.N.E. Dist 30 miles.
Later part fresh breezes from the W. repaired the main
mower. Lat 43-52

Remarks Friday Dec 7th 528th
Begins with strong winds from N.W. and increasing.
Double reefed. at 5 P.M. took in the fore and main
top sails and have too under double reefed main top
sail and reefed fore sail. head to the W. S.W. Bar. 30
at 8 P.M. close reefed the main top sail. at 10 A.M. the
wind hauled to the S.W. and moderate. Bar. 29⁹⁰/₁₀₀
Lat 43-59 Long 76-22

Remarks Saturday Dec 8th 529th
Strong winds from the S. Steering N.E. and double
reefs. at 7 P.M. huffed too. Barometer 30
Later part - strong winds from the south. Steering
N.E. at noon Huape bearing E.S.E. Dist 10 miles.

Remarks Sunday Dec 9th 530th
Begins with strong southerly winds. Steering
N. under double reef. Saw Sulphur B. at 10
and N. B. at 11. at 1 took in the fore and main
top sails. Later part strong winds from
south. Steering to the Northward. at noon off
Cocotue B. Chiloé Island.
