Remarks Monday Dec 10, 1866. 531.
Begins with strong winds from the south
at 6 P.M. Land in sight - dist 30 miles. Latter
part more moderate. Land in sight - dist 20 miles

Lat 41-40 Long 15-16
Remarks Tuesday Dec 11th 532
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W.
Latter part moderate and foggy from the westward.
Bar 29.75

Remarks Wednesday Dec 12th 533
Begins with moderate breezes from W.S.W. and
foggy. heading to the south. Latter part moderate
with foggy squalls. Lat 42-48 Long 15-45

Remarks Thursday Dec 13th 534th
Begins with moderate breezes from W.S.W.
with foggy squalls. lowered for N.B. Fish.
Latter part moderate from W.N.W. and foggy
squalls. Saw a bark steering in to the eastward past
Mucho. At noon the Island bearing E.N.E. Dist 10 miles
Lat 43-33

Remarks Friday Dec 14th 535th
Begins with fresh breezes from the westward
with foggy squalls and heavy S.W. swell.
Latter part squally. At noon the Island bearing
E.N.E. Dist 30 miles Lat 43-37

Remarks Saturday Dec 15th 536th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. and
squally. two whaling barks in sight.
Latter part pleasant breezes and fine
weather. At noon Mucho bearing E by N Dist
30 miles. Lat 43-21

Remarks Sunday Dec 16th 1866. 536th
Begins with fresh breezes from the south
and clear. Saw Sulphur Bottoms. Three barks
in sight. At 2 P.M. Mucho bearing E.N.E. Dist
15 miles head to the W.S.W. Latter part fresh
breezes. Lat 43-48 Long 15-37

Remarks Monday Dec 17th 538th
Begins with fresh breezes from the south.
At 2 P.M. Mucho bearing N by E by compass
put away for Mocha for wood. Spoke the bark
sea ranger of N. Bedford Lewis master.
Latter part moderate and fine. Course N by W
Cape Catatga bearing N by E at noon.
Lat 42-22.

Remarks Tuesday Dec 18th 539th
Begins with moderate breezes from W.S.W. and
fine. Course N.N.W. Land in sight - Dist 35 miles.
Latter part light breezes from the westward and
foggy. Lat 41-13 Long 15-02

Remarks Wednesday Dec 19th. 540th
Begins with light breezes from the westward
and foggy. at 3 1/2 P.M. cleared off. At 7 the
land in sight - Dist 45 miles. Latter part
pleasant breezes from the S.W. Course N.N.W.
Lat 40-01 Long 14-56

Remarks Thursday Dec 20th 541st
Begins with pleasant breezes from the south
course N. Saw N.B. barks N.B. Fish and Parpines.
Latter part strong winds from S.E. At 4 A.M.
made the lee of Mocha. At 11 came to anchor
in 12 fath water. Island Dist 2 miles could
not get any wood until tomorrow.
