Remarks Friday Dec 21st 1866. 542^d
Pleasant weather wind from the South
Employed getting off wood. got off 5 boat loads.

Remarks Saturday Dec 22^d 543^d
Begins with light breezes from the N.W.
At 2 P.M. civil time took the Anchor and
and started for sea. At 4 P.M. left us with
nothing but cat paws. let the chains be bent.

Remarks Sunday Dec 23^d 544th
Begins with light breezes from N.W. at 2 P.M.
Sea caught got under way. At 4 about calm.
let the chains be bent at 8 the north end of the
Island bearing N.W. by W Dist 8 miles. End of
the reef on the South end bearing S.W. by compass
Dist 5 miles calm. At 11 took a res breeze from
S.E. with rain. At 12 A.M. put the ship off and
ran around the Island to the North. Latter part rain
and calm with a heavy southerly swell. At 7 saw
the Island bearing S.W. by compass Dist 10 miles.

Remarks Monday Dec 24th 553⁻
Begin with calm and rain and a rough sea.
At 3 1/2 P.M. took a strong breeze from S.E.
heading S.W. At 5 P.M. saw the Island of Mocho
bearing by compass E by S. Dist 20 miles.
Latter part strong winds from the S. under double
reefs. Lat 37-53

Remarks Tuesday Dec 25th 546
Begins with strong winds from the South under
double reefs. Saw something afloat looked like a
Sperm whale case. Latter part Moderate with S.W.
squalls.

Remarks Wednesday Dec 26th 1866. 547^d
Begins with pleasant breezes from the South
Saw Pin Rocks. Latter part pleasant breezes.
Lat 38-20 Long 76-02

Remarks Thursday Dec 27th 548th
Begins with pleasant breezes from the South
Saw Pin Rocks. Latter part strong breezes. head-
ing S.W. by S. at 11 were to the Eastward.

Remarks Friday Dec 28th 549th
Begins with strong breezes from the South end. heading
by to the Eastward under top sails and courses.
Saw Pin Rocks. Latter part fresh breezes.

Remarks Saturday Dec 29th 550th
Begins with fresh breezes from the S. heading by to
the Eastward. At 5 P.M. made the land off Valdivia
Dist 65 miles at 8 were ship. Latter part strong
winds with squalls of S.W. At noon the land Dist 10 miles

Remarks Sunday Dec 30th 551st Lat.
Begins with strong winds from the South. At 8 P.M.
the land Dist 10 miles bearing S.E. heading to the
Westward under double reefs. Latter part strong
winds. Lat 39-39 Long 75-13

Remarks Monday Dec 31st 552^d
Begins with strong winds from the S. under
double reefs. trying to get south. Latter part strong
winds under double reefs. Lat 39-48 Long 76-06.
