 Six sails in sight. At 7 P. M. Huape bearing E
 S. E. Dist 15 miles. Heading W by S. under
 short sail. Latter part moderate and thick.
 Saw 16 birds.

Remarks Tuesday Jan 22nd 1867. 574th
 Begins with moderate breezes from the S. W.
 with big squalls. Five sails in sight.
 Latter part thick weather. Lat 13-32

Remarks Wednesday Jan 23rd 1867. 575th
 Begins with moderate breezes from S. W.
 with big squalls. At 7 P. M. Huape bearing
 N. E. Dist 25 miles. Latter part strong winds
 from the westward and thick. Saw 16 birds
 Killers and 10 fish.

Remarks Thursday Jan 24th 576
 Begins with strong westerly winds and foggy.
 Saw 16 birds. The Ocean in sight. Latter
 part moderate and thick. Lat 13-21

Remarks Friday Jan 25th 577th
 Begins with fresh breezes from S. W.
 spoke the Niger Capt. Cleveland 8 months out
 200 birds seen. Latter part moderate. Went
 on board the Dark Shephard 4 months 20 seen.
 at noon the Island bearing S. E. by S. Dist
 30 miles. Lat 13-09

Remarks Saturday Jan 26th 578
 Begins with light breezes from the south. four
 sails in sight. Latter part calm and rainy.
 at noon Huape bearing S. E. by E 30 miles.
 Dist.

 Begins with calm. At 7 P. M. Huape
 bearing S. E. by E Dist 35 miles. three sails in sight.
 Latter part moderate breezes from the North.

Remarks Monday Jan 28th 580th
 Begins with fresh breezes from the North.
 spoke the Ship Marango, Little Master.
 at 6 P. M. Double Reef. at 7 began to rain.
 Latter part breezy and thick weather. Saw 16 birds.

Remarks Tuesday Jan 29th 581st
 Begins with strong winds from W. S. W. and
 squally. Saw 16 birds. at 7 P. M. Huape bearing
 N. E. Dist 20 miles. Middle part strong winds
 and rain. Latter part wind S. W. strong.
 Lat 13-42

Remarks Wednesday Jan 30th 582nd
 Begins with strong winds from south. under
 Double Reef. Latter part moderate. At noon Huape
 bearing N. E. Dist 30 miles. Saw 16 birds.

Remarks Thursday Jan 31st 583rd
 Begins with moderate breezes from westward
 spoke the Shephard and Europa. 220 birds seen.
 at 7 Huape bearing E. N. E. Dist 25 miles.
 Latter part moderate and thick fog.

Remarks Friday Jan 31st Feb 1st 584
 Begins with moderate breezes from the west
 and foggy. at 3 P. M. the fog lifted. seven
 sails in sight. Latter part moderate and
 thick saw 16 birds.
