Remarks Sunday April 28th 1867. 67th
Begins with fresh breeze from E. under Double
Breeze Main, Top and Fore sail. Latter part more
moderate. at 1 P.M. made Massachusetts bearing S.W. Dist
30 miles. at noon Dist 15 miles. Sail & Drift.

Remarks Monday April 29th 67th
Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. Steering
to the N. got some altitudes and found the ship
25 miles to the westward which she had gained
in 8 1/2 months. Latter part moderate and fine.
Land bearing E. Dist 50 miles. Lat 33-35

Remarks Tuesday April 30th 67th
Begins with light airs from S.W. at 6 P.M.
the Island bearing E. Dist 40 miles. Latter part moderate
breeze from the N.W. steering S.W. the Island Dist 50
miles bearing E. Lat 33-35

Remarks Wednesday April May 1st 1867 68th
Begins with strong breeze from N.W. and increasing
saw a number of merchant vessels steering to N. at
1 P.M. double reefed. Latter part fresh breeze from
the S. heading E. Lat 34-38 Long 79-41

Remarks Thursday May 2nd 67th
Moderate breeze from the South and a heavy swell
heading E. saw ship & boats. Latter part moderate.
Saw ship & boats. Lat 35-05 Long 78-48

Remarks Friday May 3rd 67th
Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. heading
E. Latter part moderate from E.

Remarks Saturday May 4th 67th
Begins with light air from the N. Latter part fresh
breeze from N.W. and rainy. Course S.E. by E. at 4 P.M. No
work for 8 hours. Top sails and hipped too at noon since
hauled to the N.

Remarks Sunday May 5th 67th
Begins with strong winds from the North & E.
under Double reef. Latter part fresh breeze
from S.W. and a heavy swell. saw ship & boats.
Lat 36-48 Long 75-30

Remarks Monday May 6th 67th
Begins with fresh breeze from the S. and a heavy
swell. saw ship & boats. Latter a calm from the N.W.

Remarks Tuesday May 7th 67th
Begins with a calm from the N.W. have too under close
reef & main top sail and reefed fore sail at 4 P.M.
were ship to the N. at 8 P.M. wind hauled to the S.W.
cleared off and moderate. Latter part fresh breeze
from S. saw two ships. Lat 36-54 Long 75-25

Remarks Wednesday May 8th 68th
Begins with fresh breeze from the South.
Latter part pleasant breeze. Land in sight Dist
40 miles. Lat 36-31 Long 74-12

Remarks Thursday May 9th 68th
Begins with fresh breeze from the South.
steering N. Latter part moderate breeze from
the N.W. head N. Lat 34-50 Long 74-04

Remarks Friday May 10th 68th
Begins with moderate breeze from the N.W. at
1 1/2 P.M. wind hauled to S.E. Latter part
strong winds from S.E. Course N.
Lat 33-57 Long 76-07
