Remarks Saturday May 11th 1867. 683rd
Begins with fresh breezes from S.E. course W by S.
Latter part light air and baffling.

Lat 33-19 Long 76-58
Remarks Sunday May 12th 684th
Begins with light breezes from the westward.
Latter part light air from the S. Lat 33-19 Long 77-46

Remarks Monday May 13th 685th
Begins with light air from S.E. Juan in sight bearing
N.W. Dist 60 miles. Latter part moderate from N.W.
at noon Juan bearing S.W. Dist 40 miles Lat 33-41

Remarks Tuesday May 14th 686th
Begins with fresh breezes from W. N.W. at 4 P.M.
Juan bearing S.W. Dist 25 miles. Middle part
strong winds. at 3 P.M. took in fore and main top sails.
at noon Juan bearing S.W. by N Dist 30 miles. Lat 33-22

Remarks Wednesday May 15th 687th
Begins with moderate breezes from W. S.W. and a
heavy swell. at 6 P.M. Juan bearing W. S.W. Dist 30
miles. Latter part strong winds and squally.
Lat 33-52

Remarks Thursday May 16th 688th
Begins with strong winds from W. S.W. and squally.
Latter part calm. repaired the main top gale sail.

Remarks Friday May 17th 689th
Begins with calm. Latter part moderate breezes
from W. S.W. Juan Dist 30 miles bearing S.W.

Remarks Saturday May 18th 690th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W.
Latter part moderate at noon Juan bearing S.E.
Dist 12 miles.

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Remarks Sunday May 19th 1867. 691st
Begins with moderate breezes from W.
Latter part fresh breezes from W. N.W. saw Pin Banks
Lat 33-45

Remarks Monday May 20th 692nd
Begins with strong winds from W. N.W. at 4 P.M.
took in fore and main top sails. Mastafuera
bearing N.W. Dist 30 miles. Latter part 6 Gale, under
main top sail and fore sail. at noon
Mastafuera bearing N.W. Dist 40 miles. Lat 34-18

Remarks Tuesday May 21st 693rd
Begins with a Gale from N.W. Shore too under close
reef for main top sail and reefed fore sail. at 4 P.M. went to
the N.W. Morrell and latter blowing a heavy gale.
at 1 P.M. took in the main top sail, blowing very hard. at 10
carried away the main spencer gaff. lashed the sail in the
main rigging. so ended under fore top mast stay sail.

Remarks Wednesday May 22nd 694th
Begins with a heavy gale from N.W. under bare poles.
at 1 P.M. the wind began to haul to the westward and
moderate same. at 4 P.M. set the main top sail.
Latter part strong winds from W. S.W. Juan in sight
bearing N by E. Dist 20 miles.

Remarks Thursday May 23rd 695th
Begins with fresh breezes from W. Steering
to the N. at 6 P.M. Juan bearing S.W. Dist 5 miles
from which I take my departure for St. Philip &
Sallies Ground. Latter part moderate breezes from
N.W. at noon Juan bearing S Dist 35 miles Lat 33-00

Remarks Friday May 24th 696th
Begins with strong winds from N.W. and blowing on. at
6 P.M. took in all but close reefed main top sail and
reef fore sail. Latter strong winds.
Lat 32-39
