

Ship Alfred Gibbs toward the Marquesas.

Remarks Wednesday Aug 21<sup>st</sup> 1867 785  
Fresh trades. Course S.W. Latter  
part strong trades, repairing Casks.

Remarks Thursday Aug 22<sup>nd</sup> 786  
Begins with fresh trades. Course S.W. by S.  
Latter part strong trades employed repairing  
Grounds & forward. Lat 2-31 Long 131-41

Remarks Friday Aug 23<sup>rd</sup> 787<sup>th</sup>  
Begins strong trades and squally. Steering  
S.W. under top sails and courses, fitting the  
Grounds & forward. Latter part fresh trades. the  
Crew in company. Lat 6-49 Long 133-56.

Remarks Saturday Aug 24<sup>th</sup> 788<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh trades. Course S.W. by W.  
finished stowing of the provisions & Casks. Replaced  
by others. Only 6 Casks fit to go back without  
repairing. Latter part strong trades.

Remarks Sunday Aug 25<sup>th</sup> 1867 789<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with moderate trades. Course  
S.W. at 2 P.M. changed it to S.W. by W.  
for Macaduna. caught a Porpoise.  
at 5 1/2 A.M. made the Adriatic Rock bearing  
S.W. Dist 3 miles, and Macaduna at the same  
time Dist 20 miles, at noon bearing S.E. Dist  
five miles. Lat 9-37 Long 131-31

Remarks Monday Aug 26<sup>th</sup> 790<sup>th</sup>  
Strong winds and squally. at 7 A.M. came  
too Anchor in 12 1/2 fathoms water. & Drake cut  
the Water Pipe badly. by there 8 Days, got  
wood and water and what recruits we could  
have and put up new fore topmast & trues  
Cables.

Ship Alfred Gibbs. toward the Coast of Chile.

Remarks Tuesday Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> 1867 798<sup>th</sup>  
Strong trade and squally. at 8 A.M. took the  
Anchor. and went to Sta. Or the ship rather took  
it with 35 fathoms Chain out. and at 9 took  
us until 1 1/2 o'clock to get it to the Cat Head.  
we had to unshackle it and take it into the  
Pipe. But we got it at last. made sail  
and steered S.W. by W. the Cleane in company.

Remarks Wednesday Sept 4<sup>th</sup> 799<sup>th</sup>  
fresh trades course S.W. employed stowing  
Chains and Anchor. Latter part fresh trades.  
Lat 11-45 Long 141-56

Remarks Thursday Sept 5<sup>th</sup> 800<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh trades. Course S.W. by W.  
Latter part fresh trades. Lat 13-00 Long 144-37

Remarks Friday Sept 6<sup>th</sup> 801<sup>st</sup>  
Begins with fresh trades course S.W. at 6 P.M.  
shortened sail. Latter part fresh trades. at 8  
A.M. made water land on King George Is. at noon  
got ready to go on there to trade for Hogs.

Remarks Saturday Sept 7<sup>th</sup> 802<sup>nd</sup>  
Begins with fresh trades. at 1 P.M. I went  
on Shore. at 4 returned to the ship. got one  
hog by paying five Dollars, and eight Jacob.  
Doubt reefed and stowed S.W. moderate.  
Latter part moderate. at 6 A.M. made Hogemister  
Island. at 9 the Island bearing S.E. saw two whales  
at 9 1/2 lowered the 8 Boats the L. Boat struck a  
large whale the W. & D. a small one. Land Dist 2 miles.  
Took the large one to the Cleane. we started the  
being Chase too. took the small one to our  
Ship. So on our way to Chile.
