Remarks Thursday Sept 19th 1867. 814
Begins with moderate breezes from N.
Course S by E. for Opao. Latter part -
Moderate and fine. at 11 A.M. made the
Island of Opao bearing S by E Dist
35 Miles. Lat 27-08 Long 144-35

Remarks Friday Sept 20th 815
Begins with moderate breezes from N.W.
Setting S.E. at 4 P.M. luffed to the wind
head to the W.S.W. Opao bearing S by E
Dist 10 Miles. at 6 bearing S.E. Dist 10
Miles. Squally. Latter part calm. at 7 A.M.
I went on shore to get some logs. Land Dist 10
Miles. found that the Australian & Panama Steam
Packet line of Steamers had made it a relay station
for coaling.

Remarks Saturday Sept 21st 816th
Begins with light air and calm. at 5 P.M.
We came out of the Bay to go on board.
But found the ship so far off that we gave
it up and went on shore for the night.
at 7 A.M. started for the ship at 8 got
on board, and sailed for Pitcairn.

Begins with fresh breezes from N.W.
Course S by N. Latter part moderate and rainy.
Wind W.S.W. No Ob

Remarks Monday Sept 23rd 818th
Begins with moderate breezes from N.W.
Course S by N.W. Latter part fresh breezes from
S.W. Lat 27-09 Long 137-48

Ship Alpha left on 22nd for Pitcairn Island.

Remarks Tuesday Sept 24th 1867. 819th
Begins with fresh S.W. winds and fair. Course
S by E. Latter part moderate. Lat 26-30 Long 134-58

Remarks Wednesday Sept 25th 820th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. Course
S by E. Latter part moderate from S.E. head to the
N.E. Lat 26-03 Long 133-21

Remarks Thursday Sept 26th 821st Day.
Begins with moderate breezes from S. heading
N.N.E. Latter part pleasant breezes from E. head
N.N.E. at 11 A.M. luffed to the S.E.

Lat 24-25 Long 132-15
Remarks Friday Sept 27th 822nd
Begins with moderate breezes S.N.E. heading
S.E. Clear in company. Latter part moderate
breezes from N.N.E. heading E. Lat 23-21 Long 130-55

Remarks Saturday Sept 28th 823rd
Begins with moderate breeze from N.N.E.
heading by to the Eastward. at 9 P.M.
made Pitcairn Island bearing N by E Dist
15 Miles. at 6 P.M. luffed to the N.W.
Latter part fresh breezes at noon the Island
bearing E Dist 2 Miles. at 3 1/2 P.M. civil
time I went on shore. the ship off and
on. 11 Days. it was so rough for four
Days that we could not land & Boat.

at 5 P.M. set the men ashore at
Pitcairn after setting with them for
recruits. at 5 1/2 the boats returned to
the ship. made sail for Chili.
