Remarks Friday Oct 11th 1862 836
Begins with fresh breezes from S by N.
Course S by E, all sail set. Last sight of
the Bar k Queen at 2 O'clock, after being
in sight (of the) 82 days. Latter part fresh
breezes from N.E. repaired jibs, and painted the Boat.

Lat 27-43 Long 130-29

Remarks Saturday Oct 12th 837th
Begins with fresh breezes from N. Course
S by E. at 7 P.M. changed the S Course to S by E
to give a reported group of Islands a greater
birth. S by E, if they are right on the chart,
would give them 38 miles Dist when abreast
of them. Middle part fresh breezes from the N and
raining. Latter part wind to S.W. Course S by E.

Lat 32-24 Long 130-08

Remarks Sunday Oct 13th 838th
Begins with moderate breezes from
S.W. Course S by E. Latter part light air
from E.N.E.

Lat 33-18 Long 129-34

Remarks Monday Oct 14th 839th
Begins with light air from E.N.E. Course S by E.
Latter part fresh breezes from N.N.W. Beat
a new main top sail set. Lat 34-45 No Ob.

Remarks Tuesday Oct 15th 840th
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. and
raining, at 5 P.M. wind hauled to the S.W.
and let up. Latter part fresh breezes from S.W.
Course E.N.E.

Lat 37-05 Long 125-57

Remarks Wednesday Oct 16th 841th
Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. Course
E.N.E. Latter part - Calm. Lat 37-55

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Remarks Thursday Oct 17th 1862 842
Begins with light air from the N. Course
E.N.E. Latter part strong winds from the N.W.
and raining. No Ob.

Remarks Friday Oct 18th 843th
Begins with fresh breezes from the Course E by S.
all sail set. Latter part a Gale from the
Westward running in, at 11h A.M. parted the Star
main top sail sheet. Double reefed and set the
sail again.

Lat 40-57 Long 116-58

Remarks Saturday Oct 19th 844th
Begins with a Gale from the West running
E by N. at 5 P.M. have too. The sea was so
heavy I was afraid of the Boats.
Latter more moderate. at 8 O'clock put the ship
on her Course under Double Reefed main top sail
and bare sail. Close reefed fore sail.

Lat 40-43 Long 115-26

Remarks Sunday Oct 20th 845th
Begins with strong winds from N.W.
and a rough sea. Course E by N.
Latter part fresh breezes from N.N.W. and cloudy.
No Ob.

Remarks Monday Oct 21st 846th
Begins with strong winds from N.W. and raining.
at 2 P.M. took in top sail. at 3 Double reefed
the top sails and furled the main sail. Course E.
Latter part fresh N.W. winds and thick weather. E by N.
No Ob.

Remarks Tuesday Oct 22nd 847th
Fresh breezes from N.W. and thick weather Course E by N.
Latter part moderate breezes from S.E. and cloudy.
No Ob.
