Heading by to the S.W. Latter part - fresh breezes.

Lat 43-30 Long 78-02
Remarks Monday Dec 2nd 888th
Began with strong winds from W and squally head
to the S under double reef. at 7 took in Bar & began
Sails. Latter part - a Gale from N.W. with heavy squalls.
Under close reefed main top sail. at 10 A.M. the wind
hauled to the W.S.W. in a squall. Lat 44-11 Long 78-22

Remarks Tuesday Dec 3rd 889th
Began with a Gale from W.S.W. heavy squalls. at
7 P.M. moderated some. Let the fore sail reef. with
a close reefed main top sail. Latter part still a Gale.

Lat 44-02 Long 78-12
Remarks Wednesday Dec 4th 890th
Began with a Gale from W.N.W. head to the S.W.
Under close reefed main top sail and reefed fore sail.
at 4 P.M. took in the fore sail. B.D. 29th
Latter part more moderate. Lat 44-28 Long 78-12

Remarks Thursday Dec 5th 891th
Began with strong winds from W.S.W. head to the
N.W. under close reefed top sails. Latter part strong
winds from W. put away for the Coast under double
reef main top sail and fore sail. Lat 44-11 Long 77-10

Remarks Friday Dec 6th 892th
Began with strong winds from W. steering E.S.E.
under short sail. at 7 P.M. heaved too head to the S.W.
Latter part moderate breezes from N.W. heading
to N.E. thick weather. No Obs.

Remarks Saturday Dec 7th 1867 893th
Began with fresh breezes from N.W. and rainy.
Spoke the bark B.D. Colcord and bark Mar.
Wiale and latter part, a Gale from N.W. and rainy. at 10 A.M.
the wind hauled in a squall to the S.W. Ship under close
reefed main top sail and reefed fore sail the bark &
Colcord in sight. No Obs.

Remarks Sunday Dec 8th 894th
Began with a Gale from S.W. hove too head to the
W. under close reefed main top sail and reefed fore sail.
Latter part light air from S. heading in for Socorro. at
noon the Island bearing by compass E by N 11 N Dist 10 miles.
Three sails in sight.

Remarks Monday Dec 9th 895th
Began with light breezes. Spoke the bark
Mar. 24 May 1430 Mm. Latter part light
air from the S. at noon Socorro bearing E by N 11 N
Dist 10 miles. Three sails in sight.

Lat 44-44 Long 75-28
Remarks Tuesday Dec 10th 896th
Began with light air from the S and calm.
at night the Island bearing E.N.E. Dist 20 miles.
at 8 1/2 P.M. put away for Huafu. Latter part
moderate breezes from S. steering for Huafu.
at noon the Island Dist 30 miles.
Saw no back. Lat 43-44

Remarks Wednesday Dec 11th 897th
Began with moderate breeze from S.E. and rainy.
Spoke the Clane. at night Huafu bearing
E by N Dist 30 miles. Latter part fresh breezes
and squally.
