

Ship Alfred Gibbs cruising off Mocha.

Remarks Monday Jan 28th 1868. 945
Begin with a gale from the S. saw two sails.
Ship under Double reefed main top sail and fore
sail. Latter part the gale continues. Lat 37-47 Long 75-25

Remarks Wednesday Jan 29th 946th
Begin with a gale from the S. under Double
reefed main top sail and reefed fore sail. Latter part
gale still continues. under close reefed main top sail and
reefed fore sail. At 1 1/2 P.M. the ship made a plunge and
a sea breaking at the same time. Struck the fifth boom
drawing the gun bolts from the bow. Carried it away
about a foot outside the cap. It took until 5 A.M.
to clear the wrecked spar away and get it in board.

Remarks Thursday Jan 30th 947th
Begin with a gale from the S. Ship under
close reefed main top sail and reefed fore sail.
Latter part more moderate. Set close reefed top sails.
Lat 37-18 Long 75-50

Remarks Friday Jan 31st 948th
Begin with strong S.W. winds. Under
close reefed top sails. Latter part fresh breezes
with big squalls. Employed making fifth boom.
Lat 37-18 Long 75-23

Remarks Saturday Feb 1st 1868. 949th
Begin with fresh breezes from the S. Employed
making fifth boom. Latter part strong winds.
Lat 37-12

Remarks Sunday Feb 2nd 950th
Begin with strong winds from the S.
Latter part strong wind from S.E.
Under close reefed fore & main top sails
and double reefed main.
Lat 37-12 Long 75-56

Remarks Monday Feb 3rd 1868. 951st
Begin with strong winds from S.E. Latter
part a gale. under close reefed fore & main top sails
and reefed fore sail. Lat 37-11 Long 75-13

Remarks Tuesday Feb 4th 952nd
Begin with a gale from the S.E. under close
reefed fore and main top sails and reefed fore sail.
Latter part more moderate. worked on the fifth
boom. Lat 37-02

Remarks Wednesday Feb 5th 953rd
Begin with strong winds from S. at dark
On the fifth boom. Latter part a gale.
Lat 36-53 Long 75-37

Remarks Thursday Feb 6th 954th
Begin with a gale from the S.E. under
close reefed main top sail and reefed fore sail.
Latter part gale continues. under close reefed main
top sail. Lat 36-24 Long 75-38

Remarks Friday Feb 7th 955th
Begin with a gale from S.E. under close reefed
main top sail. Latter part little more moderate.
Set double reefed fore and main top sails and reefed
fore sail. w. a very rough sea. Lat 36-13 Long 75-59

Remarks Saturday Feb 8th 956th
Begin with strong winds from the S. finished
the fifth boom. 10 Day since we carried it away.
and there has been but one good day since. there
has been four whaling days in the last 21 day.
Latter part moderate. sent out the new fifth
boom and bent the sails. The boom fitted
like a mill.
