Remarks Sunday Feb 9th 1868. 957th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W.
 Latter part moderate breezes from N.W. by N. steering
 S by E. all sail set. the first time we had the reef out of the
 top sails for two weeks. 30-40

Remarks Monday Feb 10th. 958th
Begins with fresh breezes from the N.W. by N. and thick
 weather. It has the appearance of a squall. Latter part
 calm and rainy. 30-40

Remarks Tuesday Feb 11th 959th
Begins with calm and rain. at 3 P.M. came on a
 gale from N.W. at 6 wind hauled to S.W.
 Latter part fresh from N.W. Lat 37-57

Remarks Wednesday Feb 12th 960th
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. saw
 Mocha Dist 30 miles. Latter part moderate winds
 from S.E. and fine. Lat 38-20 Long 75-19

Remarks Thursday Feb 13th 961st
Begins with pleasant breezes from S.E. by S and
 fine. at 7 P.M. Mocha bearing S by N Dist 30 miles.
 Latter part strong winds from S.E. sent the fore sail
 down to repair. It is hard work to get weather to repair
 damages. Much more to whale it. The main sail has been
 in the sail for a month wait for a chance and weather to
 repair it. Lat 37-40

Remarks Friday Feb 14th. 962nd
Begins with strong southerly winds. under double
 reefed main and close reefed fore and main top sails.
 Latter part strong winds. under close reefed
 top sails. Lat 37-26-

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Remarks Saturday Feb 15th 1868. 963rd
Begins with strong wind from S.E. under close
 reefed top sails. Land in sight. Latter part fine
 breezes. fitted the main top sail. Lat 37-27

Remarks Sunday Feb 16th. 964th
Begins with moderate breezes from S by E. Land
 in sight Dist 30 miles. Latter part calm. fine weather.
 Lat 37-12 Long 74-50

Remarks Monday Feb 17th. 965th
Begins with calm and fine weather. Land in sight Dist
 50 miles. Latter part strong winds from the N. under double
 reefed. a whaling bark in sight. Lat 36-57 Long 75-35

Remarks Tuesday Feb 18th. 966th
Begins with a gale from the N. at 11 P.M. wind hauled to
 the S. Latter part calm and fine. repaired the main sail.

Remarks Wednesday Feb 19th 967th
Begins with moderate breezes from W.N.W. and fine.
 Latter part fresh breezes from the N. Lat 37-20 Long 75-16

Remarks Thursday Feb 20th 968th
Begins with fresh breezes from W.N.W. at 5 hauled
 to the S.W. Latter part fine. drying down.
 Lat 37-42

Remarks Friday Feb 21st. 969th
Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. Caught
 a Lizard Fish. Latter strong wind
 and rain from W.N.W. at 10 A.M. hauled to the S.W.
 Lat 38-01 Long 75-06

Remarks Saturday Feb 22nd 970th
Begins with strong southerly winds. Latter part
 fresh breezes from S.E. Spoke the bark
 John Gilpin John Cavallance Master.
 Land in sight. Lat 37-21
