Remarks Tuesday Aug¹⁰th 1861
Begin with fresh breezes from N to W
with occasional heavy squalls. Course N to
W, when the wind will abate - of it, raising
basty weather. Ship under top sails and
caluses. Latter part - calm and rain.

Remarks Wednesday Aug¹¹th 1861
Begin with calm and light air from all
quarters. course N to by N when the wind goes in.
Latter part - light air from N to N E.

Lat 12-16 Long 40-11

Remarks Thursday Aug¹²th 1861
Begin with light air from the N E
heading N N to all sail set.
Latter part the same. Painting same in
the cabin.

Lat 12-30 Long 40-35

Remarks Friday Aug¹³th 1861
Begin with light air from N E, heading
N N to. all sail set, bent the main top
sail. Latter part a little more
breeze. Employed painting yards and the
out side of the ship.

Lat 13-12 Long 41-19

Remarks Saturday Aug¹⁴th 1861
Begin with moderate breezes from N E
heading N N to. Latter part moderate
breeze from N E by E. Course N to by
N. Employed painting spar, put up a
preventer back stay to the main top gall
mast.

Lat 13-12 Long 43-19

Begin with fresh breezes from N E by E.
Course N to by N. all sail set.
Latter part fresh breeze from N E by N.
heading by to the N to by N. Bare and mizen
royal furled

Remarks Monday Aug¹⁶th 1861
Begin with fresh breezes from N E. Course
N to by N. Bare and mizen royal and top gall
sail furled, all the other set to the wind.
Latter part moderate breezes from N E by E.
Employed painting spar and washing ship.

Lat 17-18 Long 48-00

Remarks Tuesday Aug¹⁷th 1861
Begin with moderate breezes from E N E
Course N to by N. all sail set. lowered
a boat and picked up four men.
Latter part the same. saw the first
Gulf weed.

Lat 21-26 Long 50-04

Remarks Wednesday Aug¹⁸th 1861
Begin with moderate breezes and
baffling from E N E to E E with rain
squalls. all drawing sail set. Latter part
moderate breezes. Employed painting the masts
and the top. I offered to bet yesterday
that the Courser had not got in.

Begin with moderate breezes from E by N.
Course N to. Employed painting.
Latter part moderate breeze from E by N.
