Remarks Continued on Board

61st day

Wednesday May 5th

First part fine breeze from the E. N. E. steering the same under all sail except fore top g. sail nothing in sight. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the E by N steering by the wind under all sail but fore top g. sail. saw 3 sails. painted the over head boats also painted the line but cover broke out paint oil & Beef

62nd

Thursday May 6th

This day begins with a strong breeze from the E. N. E. steering by the wind under the same sail on the Starboard tack 1 sail in sight. made a jib for the Mast Boat & Broke out the shells for Coon. Mid part steering the same. Latter part light breeze from the S. E. steering to the N. E. under all sail (nothing in sight. employed in making Boat jibs. come up with the mizen top mast back stays served them & set them up and

63rd

Friday May 7th

First part the same. Broke out the old fore stay and striped it stowed it below. again sent in the bowsprit sprout for repairs. at 4:42 o'clock raised a school of Black fish to the windward of the ship. immediately lowered all the Boats & gave chase. Bow Boat struck & turned up one. shortly after the Mast Boat struck but men drew the fore part of

Bk Globe by Chase & Allen

At 6 42 o'clock took him along side & hoisted him in. shortly after the other Boats came aboard. headed forward steering N. N. E. wind light from the S. E. all sail out. Mid part light breeze. Latter part very light breeze from the S. E. steering N. N. E. under all sail. nothing in sight. cleared away the Blackfish & hauled the blubber

4th day

Sat May 8th 1869

First part nearly calm. saw Albicore. employed in setting and grinding iron also at work on a jib for Bow Boat. Mid part light breeze from the S. E. steering N. N. W. Latter part breeze very light from the S. E. steering N. N. W. under all sail. broke out water. tried out the Blubber turned up 1 barrel. broke out Flour. at 10 o'clock raised a large white water off the lee Bow. run for it about all hour & then made them out to be hump backs. saw 2 sails

5th day

Sun May 9th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S. E. steering the same under all sail hump Backs & Alacore in sight. also 1 sail broke out molasses. Mid part the same. Latter part very light breeze from the S. E. steering N. N. W. under all sail 1 sail in sight. this has been a beautiful day would that I could of been at home in order to go to Church
