

On Board *Pt. Globe*

86th day

May 30th - 1869

This day commence with a calm chased Blackfish until half past one o'clock. & then returned to the ship without success. The Blackfish acting very shy. This morning some one made a Tar-bucket fast to the fore-top-sail. Once on the main-top and when the brace was started the Tar-bucket was captured the Tar lodging on the Larboard over head Boat also on the Booby hatch finished setting the main-top-mast-rigging. made a new hose but broke out water & flour. at half past 2. o'clock made all sail but fore-top & sail at sundown shortened sail as usual. Mid part calm. Latter part calm. set the reef out and set main-top & sail & jibe nothing in sight.

87th

Mon May 31st 1869

First part. A light breeze from the N.E. but soon died away again. Saw dolphin & grampuses. at sundown double reefed & furlled the light-sails. Mid part calm. Latter part. Bearly calm. saw jumpers. broke out the gun for paint-painted the jib jumpers. Bob stays. Deckmen also painted over the post-around the Bow. seized on 4. rattles in the main-top-mast rigging put on a new span line to the main-top-mast & top-gallant backstays. made 2 scotch men for the fore-top-mast back stays. made all sail except fore-top-gallant sail.

Remarks 1869

Tuesday June 1st 1869

This day commence with a light-breeze from the W. steering by the wind on the Port-lack. I saw grampuses & 9. sail. painted the line tub racks to the quarter Boat also painted the Starboard forward beam. at sundown shortened sail as usual. Mid part steering by the wind on the Port-lack. Latter part. moderate-breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind under all sail except fore-top-gallant-sail on the same tack. Nothing seen. broke out a cask of Bread, and a barrel of Beef.

Wednesday June 2nd

First part. The same. Saw jumpers rigged lanyards to the hose tub. at 6 o'clock. Tacked ship heading N.W. by the wind. Mid part steering by the wind under all sail but fore-top-gallant sail. Latter part fresh breeze from the E. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. Nothing in sight. made bent gaskets for main & sail.

Thursday June 3rd

First part light breeze from the E. steering the same. Nothing in sight. made a whip rope. Saw a shark. Mid part light breeze. Tacked ship at 12 o'clock. heading E. by N. by the wind under all sail but fore-top & sail. Latter part calm. Saw grampuses & dolphin. painted the jib jumpers & Bob stays. sent in the fore-top-mast stay sail sheet-jumpers for repairing repaired them & sent them out.
