

On Board B^t Globe June 1869

706th

Sat. June 19th

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the N. & E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Nothing in sight. At sundown took in the light sail & double reefed the top sails. Saw a large dog. Had part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the N & E steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Saw 1 sail broke out water. Meat & Molluscs.

707th

Sun. June 20th

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the N & E steering by the wind on the Port tack under all sail. At 5¹/₂ o'clock raised a school of Blackfish. Lowered all the Boats & gave chase. The Bomb Boat struck but drew shortly after at sundown returned to the ship with no fish. At sundown took in the light sail & double reefed. Had part the same. Latter part light breeze from the N. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. Back ship at 6 o'clock lowered for a turtle caught him not.

708th

Mon. June 21st

This day commences with a light breeze from the N. steering the same. Saw a school of Blackfish. The Capt. lowered the Starboard Boat & chased them about an hour did not get near them. The Capt. shot at one did not hurt him. Had. At 6 o'clock the Bow Boat gave chase at 5¹/₂ o'clock all returned to the ship. Saw porpoise & a fin back.

Cruising for Sperm Whales

Had part calm. Latter part the same raised a school of Blackfish. The Capt. lowered the Starboard Boat & gave chase shot several times killed one and returned to the ship at 8 o'clock hoisted him on deck & got Breakfast. After getting breakfast the Capt. & Mate Boat left the ship in pursuit of the school again. Chased them until 11 o'clock & then returned without success. The Bow Boat lowered this morning but caught them not the first seting very shy & wild striped the fish & minced & skinned it. Saw grampus.

Tue. June 22nd

This day commences with a light breeze from the N & W steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Nothing in sight. Mid. & Latter part light breeze from the N. & W. steering N. & E under all sail broke out 3 barrel of meat out of the after hold in order to get at the water in the ground tier. Broke out water & stowed the meat in the fore hold. Saw several pieces of squid. Lat 36. 29. N. Long

10th

Wednesday June 23rd

This day commences with a light breeze from the N & W steering the same under all sail. Saw corfish & fin back. Also drift stuff. At 5¹/₂ o'clock raised a sail. Tried out the Blackfish turned up 80 gallons. Had part light breeze from the N. steering N. & E under all sail. Latter part moderate breeze from the W. steering the same. Caught a porpoise.
