

Remarks on Board B. B. Glover

134th day

Tue. July 17th 1869

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the W. S. steering by the wind under at 3 o'clock took in the main top gallant sail at 4 1/2 o'clock took in the flying jib & gaff. Tacked top sail stroke out water employed in making dunnit Dec. to keep the sails from being busy. At sundown double reefed furled the main sail & jib & spanker. Heated the spanker. At 11 o'clock strong breeze from the W. S. and squally at 1 o'clock took in the fore top sail. blowing strong. Latter part strong breeze from the N. W. and squally with rain. at 10 o'clock set the fore top sail jib & spanker & main sail.

135th

Tue. July 18th 1869

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the N. W. steering by the wind on the Port tack. took out Flour & Molasses for the rope out at 2 1/2 o'clock & whipping jib & gaff top sail. water employed in making dunnit & dunnit. at sundown tacked ship & double reefed steering the same saw comets. Had part light breeze from the N. & W. Latter part steering S. E. under all sail nothing in sight. Lat 33.48 Lon 40.29

136th

Mon. July 19th

This day commence with a moderate breeze from the S. & W. steering to the S. & E. under the same sail saw 1 sail. I suppose we are working towards the Islands. at sundown took in the light sails double reefed & furled. Latter part steering the same. Latter part light breeze from the N. & W. made all sail steering to the S. & E. sent down main spencer to shorten it on the head employed in setting at sundown dunnit.

Western Ground July 20 1869

37th

Tue. July 20th 1869

This day commence with a light breeze from the Westward. steering to the S. & E. under all sail bent the main spencer. at half past 3. raised a school of Black fish luffed to the wind and lowered the Larboard Mast & Bow. Boats & gave chase. shot at them several. (time the Capt. killing a small one at sundown returned to the ship. shot the fish & took in the light sails & double reefed the top sails steering by the wind on the Port tack. Had part the same. Latter part light breeze from the N. steering S. E. by E. made all sail except fore top of sail. ~~striking~~ making dunnit. & leaned the blubber also repaired the missing tub. saw grampus.

38th

Wednesday July 21st

This day commence with a light breeze from the N. steering to the Eastward under all sail. caught 2. dolphin employed in waxing turn. lowered the Larboard Boat for a bottle but caught him not at sundown took in the light sails & double reefed heading the same. At 11 o'clock part the same. Latter part light breeze from the N. & W. steering to the N. & E. under all sail sent down the fore top sail for repair. employed in repairing it. Saw a school of Blackfish lowered the Larboard Mast & Bow. Boats and gave chase the Capt. shot several times but did not hurt them much.
