

Continued Remarks on Board B²

139th day

Wednesday Aug 11th 1864

This day commenced with a fresh breeze accompanied with rain squalls from the S.E. beating for the Island. (gannet) at 8.0 o'clock parted from the said ship got 2 bushels of potatoes from her. in clearing away the Starboard Boat the steering oar got broke. at sundown took in the light sails the land about 10 miles distant (breeze light) No id part heading to the Eastward by the wind on the Starboard tack at 3.0 o'clock made all sail breeze very light. Latter part light air from the S.E. beating up for the Land. Saw gramp.

160th

Thursday Aug 12th 1864

This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under all sail but fore-top. Gallant sail rickled 4 times the land being about 5 miles distant. Saw gramp. at 5.0 o'clock set the Ensign heading in towards shore. at 6.0 o'clock a boat came from shore. hauled the head yards aback for the Boat to come aboard. at sundown the Boat left. hoisted forward on the Starboard standing off shore. No id part laying off & on under all sail but fore-top & sail. Latter part light breeze from the S.E. at 7.12.0 o'clock the Captⁿ went ashore at Richburg. at 11.0 o'clock the Boat returns to ship. Five of the men have deserted. Lom. Maston & Carey. Their things were brought off. an English Brig laying off and on for provisions.

Globe Off Shore N. I

141st

Friday Aug 13th 1864

This day commenced with a light breeze from the S.E. laying off & on Captⁿ ashore. at 2.12.0 o'clock the Boat returned to the shore. at 5.12.0 o'clock the Boat came to ship bringing a dressed Bullock & about 10 bushels of Potatoes & 1 bbl. of onions. after supper Boat went ashore to carry the Captⁿ taking 40 lbs. of Bread. to trade with this Brig for sugar. &c. also took 11 lbs. of Pork. this Brig has been short of provisions for about 25 days. No id part Laying off & on. Latter part laying off & on. Took aboard 114 bushels of potatoes & 14,000 onions and about 2 casks of green corn. and 5 bushels of apples. employed in stowing these things away. Sent 2 rats ashore for water. the day light breeze from the S. sold - bble Blackfish.

62nd

Sat Aug 14th

First part the same. water came off at 3.0 o'clock hoisted it in and stowed it below. 60 bble all sold. 2 men from shore came aboard and purchased 4 boxes of Tobacco at sundown had the decks all clear. No id part fresh breeze. No id part. Latter part light breeze from the Southward beating up for Santa Cruz. under all sail but fore-top & sail. Saw 4 sails. employed in picking up onions & stringing pumpkins. the Boat returned to the ship last night bringing off 7 men from shore. stowed the onions below a small cask.
