

From Western Islands to South Atlantic

194th day

Tue. Sept. 14th 1868

This day commences with a light breeze from the N. heading S.W. by S under all sail. Saw Albicore. The Capt. rigged the green Portuguese out with oil clothes & co.

Lat 11.20

Mid part rainy with a light breeze from the N. & W. Latter part calm. nothing in sight

Long 27. 03

195th day

Wed. Sept. 15th

This day commences with a rain squall & ends with a light breeze from the South caught the fresh water cask full of water caught 8 fish from along side. Made a new fly jib late shape. Took in fore top of sail at 11 o'clock. also took in mizzen top mast stay sail did not wash off the decks to night. I think it quite remarkable. Mid part nearly calm.

Lat 11.27

Latter part calm. nothing seen. Put 2 patches on the main top sail & mended the fore reef.

196th day

Thursday Sept. 16th

This day commences with a light breeze from the South heading by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail & sail in sight. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the North heading to the Southward under all sail. The Capt.

Lat 11.24

Made a Girdle Box for the Cook.

197th day

Friday Sept. 17th

This day commences with a light breeze from the North steering S.W. by S under all sail nothing seen. Mid part light breeze from the N.E. steering to the S.W. under all sail. Latter part the same. Had some rain. (caught a dolphin). Saw 1 sail.

Lat 11.09

It is very warm here at present & with that I had a glass of ice water.

Ocean on Board. Bk Globe. of N. 13

Sat. Sept. 18th 1868

This day commences with a light air from the N.E. steering to the S.W. under all sail. 1 sail in sight. Nothing going on about deck. Brown dove not seem to get any better has been off duty for about 2 months he is very bad off. Mid part steering by the wind under all sail. Shortened sail several times during the night. Latter part squally with rain. Nothing seen.

198th day

Sun. Sept. 19th 1868

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.W. heading to the N. the S under all sail but fore top gallies. Saw nothing in sight. broke out water has been raining all the afternoon at 6 o'clock single reefed the fore top sail & took in the light sails. The storage is leaking badly. as for my part I wish the ship was along side of the wharf where I live. Mid part rained until 10 1/2 o'clock & then cleared off breezing up strong from the S.W. heading by the wind under all sail. took in the light sails & set them again also set the reef out of the fore top sail. Latter part fresh breeze from the W by S heading S by the wind under all sail but fore top gallant sail. sent down the fore top of sail for repair. caught a porpoise.

200th day

Mon. Sept. 20th

First part fine weather heading South under all sail but fore top of sail. 1 sail in sight. Mid part light breeze from the W steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Latter part the same repaired & bent the fore top of sail. Saw porpoise & a crew whale & man of the ship.
