201st day

Tues. Sept. 21st 1861 204th

This day commence with a light breeze from the W. accompanied with rain. Saw a large merchantman heading to the N.E. took in fore. top of sail & set it again. Made part the same. Latter part strong breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. Nothing in sight. cleaned out the pots & washed several skins of wine, &c.

202nd

Wednes. Sept. 22nd 205th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S.W. steering the same under all sail. nothing in sight. Made part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard. Tack. Saw several gumpies. broke out canvas to make a new spanker. employed in making the spanker.

203rd

Lat 4. 22

Thursday. Sept. 23rd

This day commence the same nothing seen employed in making the spanker. Price had a tooth pulled. Made part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. All sail employed in making the spanker. Saw 5 sails raised a school of Blackfish at 10¹². o'clock lowered all the Boats & gave chase. The Starboard Boat struck and turned up and brought him along side & hoisted him in. Boats came aboard at 1. Lat 3. 37

Continued Remarks

Friday Sept. 24th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S.W. steering the same under all sail. Boats returned to the ship at 7. o'clock. employed in stripping the fish & cutting up the meat for salting to sell in the Port of Trinidad. Made part the same. Latter part strong breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. Nothing in sight. salted the Blackfish meat which was 4¹² barrels. Saw porpoise.

Lat 3. 07.

Sat. Sept. 25th

This day commence with a strong breeze from the S.W. heading the same under all sail. nothing in sight. parted foretop of sheet spliced at 8 o'clock in again. Sold my Accordeon to Joseph Rose for 6 dollars (received 1 dollar cash). Made part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Latter part strong breeze from the S.W. heading S.E. by the wind on the same. Tack nothing in sight. bought out the Blackfish blubber burned up 2¹² barrels. broke out water meat & repaired mizzen top mast stay sail.
