

On Board Bk Globe

Mon Sept. 27th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail nothing in sight. Mid part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the same tack. The old Low gave birth to 5 pigs. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering the same under all sail saw porpoises caught 1 employed in salting made a spreader for main top gaff.

Tues. Sept. 28th

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W. heading E.S.E. by the wind on the Starboard tack. Saw a school of black fish. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack saw porpoises and a fin back buoy out the porpoise blubber. Long 7.02

Wednes Sept. 29th

First part the same saw porpoises saw 1 sail. Mid part light breeze heading S.E. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the same tack saw porpoises broke out meal saw 1 sail Long 5.30

Thursday Sept. 30th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Saw hump back & porpoises and 1 sail. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack caught a confish. raised a school of black fish lowered all the Boat and gave chase saw 1 sail at 11.00 clock without success.

Near the Line

October 1869

Friday October 1st

This day commence with a light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail nothing in sight. (Salted the confish meat.) Mid part light breeze from the S.W. heading South by the wind on the Starboard tack. Latter part steady breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the same tack saw grampuses (broke Butter out Butter) took the potatoes out of the fore hold pickled out rotten ones and put them in the pen hoisted the pickled onions out of the fore hold & stowed them in the after hold. Took the coffee out of the cask and stowed it in the run. Broke out water & saw 1 sail Lat 00.15 South

Sat Oct. 2nd

This day commence with a light breeze from the S.W. steering the same under all sail saw a school of black lowered all the Boats and gave chase the Starboard Boat struck 2 but drew from them shortly after the Mast Boat struck one but also drew from him. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the same tack broke out Bread & Pork. broke out the remainder of the potatoes & put them in the pen nothing in sight.

Lat. 1.01 South

Long 2.24 W

pumped 2 casks of salt water in the main hold in order to trim ship.
