

Continued Remark from St. Helena

248th Sun. Nov. 7th 1869
This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under double reefed top sail & courses jib & spanker employed in making dippers &c. nothing in sight. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.E. steering to the S.W. made all sail but fore top & sail nothing in sight.

249th Mon. Nov. 8th 1869
This day commenced the same. nothing in sight. (Chase about the same) Mid part light breeze from the E.S.E. steering the same. under the same sail. Latter part calm. nothing in sight.

250th Tues. Nov. 9th 1869
This day commenced with a calm at 3 o'clock raised a school of small Black fish lowered all the boats & gave chase until 5 o'clock with out success. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under all sail but fore top & sail on the Port. back broke out water.

251st Wed. Nov. 10th 1869
Lat. 27.38
This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.E. accompanied with rain squalls broke out the shop cask to supply some of the Portuguese with clothing. nothing in sight. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under all sail except fore top & sail. nothing in sight. employed in making dippers &c. Chase on the gaining hand he has been a very sick man.

To the South West - Bk Globe

252nd day Thursday Nov. 11th
This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under all sail except fore top & gallant sail. nothing in sight. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the E by S steering to the South. under the same sail. nothing in sight.

253rd Friday Nov. 12th
This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the E. steering to the S. under the same sail at sundown took in the light sails. nothing in sight. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.E. by E steering by the wind under top sail courses jib & spanker flying jib & aft top sail nothing in sight.

254th Sat. Nov. 13th
This day began the same. nothing in sight. hung a bit to the Broad cast. Chase the sick man on the gain. At sundown took in the light sails. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.E. steering South under all sail but top & sail.

255th Sun. Nov. 14th
This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the E.S.E. steering to the South under the same sail broke out water & meat. nothing in sight. At sundown took in the flying jib. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S steering South under all sail except fore top & sail. at 9.20 o'clock raised a white water off the weather. Boat run for
