

Continued Remarks on Board Bk Globe

273th

Friday Dec. 3rd 1869

This day commences with a light breeze from the N. steering S by W. under all sail nothing in sight. At sundown took in the light sail & double reefed also furlled the main sail. Mid part of the same latter part fresh breeze from the N. steering to the S & E made all sail but fore top sail broke out water. Lat 33.45

274th

Sat Dec 4th

This day commences the same steering to the S & E. at sundown took in the light sail double reefed & furlled the main sail jib & spanker. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the N & W. at daylight set main sail jib and spanker saw several fin backs. at 11 o'clock took in the main sail blowing strong Lat 33.38.

275th

Sun Dec 5th 1869

This day commences with a strong breeze from the N & W steering by the wind on the Starboard Tack. Saw fin backs at 8 1/2 o'clock took in the fore top sail jib & spanker blowing a light gale accompanied with rain. Cooper made a bang for the back. put the Waist & Bow Boat on the upper Orange at sundown close reefed the main top sail Mid & Latter part blowing a gale.

276th

Mon Dec 6th 1869

This day commences with a light gale from the N.W. laying too on the Port Tack set a reef out of the main top sail (this forenoon) nothing in sight. At sundown set the fore top sail Mid part moderating. Latter part light breeze from the N.W. steering by the wind made all sail but fore top sail.

Broke out chase & med. two several fin backs

277th

Tue Dec 7th

This day commences with a light breeze from the N.W. with a heavy swell. saw several fin backs. at sundown took in the light sail & double reefed the top sail (Cooper made a checker board.) Mid part the same latter part fresh breeze from the S & W steering to the S.E. under all sail but fore top sail broke out water saw several fin backs employed in picking salmon etc.

278th

Wednesday Dec 8th

This day commences the same fin backs in sight. (Mr Penny taken sick) at sundown took in light sail double reefed the top sail & furlled the main sail also wore ship Mid part the same. Latter part steering S & E under all sail but top sail saw fin backs broke out flour.

279th

Thursday Dec 9th

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the N. steering to the S & E. under top sail & course saw fin backs & porpoise. at sundown double reefed furlled the main sail jib & spanker. & luffed to the wind on the Port Tack. Mid part the same latter part light breeze from the N.W. steering by the wind backed at 6 1/2 o'clock shade all sail but top sail.

280th

Friday Dec 10th

This day commences the same at 6 1/2 o'clock raised a school of Blackfish going quick to the wind ward. lowered the Waist & Starboard Boats and gave chase until sundown without success at sundown double reefed & furlled the main sail.
