

Remarks on Board B³ Globe

345th

Sun Feb. 13th - 1870

This day commences the same. broke out - water. at sundown double reefed the top sail & took in flying jib. Mid part strong breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind. Latter part the same.

346th

Mon. Feb. 14th

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering East at sundown took in the jib spunk & main sail. Mid part the same. Latter part strong breeze from the S.E. steering N.E. by N. under main top sail & double reefed fore top sail & courses (set up the fore stay)

347th

Tues Feb. 15th

This day commences the same. broke out a cask of Bread at sundown took in sail to double reefed main top sail & fore sail & luffed it on the Starboard tack. Mid part the same. wore ship at 12 o'clock. Latter part fresh breeze from the South - steering N.E. by N. under all sail saw conch fish & sunfish.

348th

Wednesday Feb. 16th

This day commences the same. saw a steamer under short sail. at sundown took in the main top of sail & double reefed. Mid part the same. wore ship at 1 o'clock. Latter part light breeze from the S.E. steering to the N. under all sail saw juncos & a diamond fish. broke out molasses also took the empty cask out of the mixer hatch.

Between Whaling Ground & St Helena

349th day

Thursday Feb. 17th

This day commences the same at 3 o'clock raised a school of Blackfish. lowered all the boats and caught 3. one to L.B. and 1 to W.B. and another to B. Boat took them along side & hoisted them in. Mid part at sundown shortened sail to double reefed top sail & fore sail steering by the wind. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering N. under all sail employed in mincing the blubber, hoke out water & Butter.

350th day

Friday Feb. 18th

This day commences the same. employed in sailoring & co. at sundown luffed to and took in the light sails & double reefed. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering N. under all sail boiled the Blackfish blubber. turned out 90 gallons.

351th day

Sat. Feb. 19th - 1870

This day commences the same at sundown luffed to the wind & shortened sail. Mid part the same. Latter part moderate weather made all sail made a new bunt gasket to main top of sail.

352nd day

Sun. Feb. 20th - 1870

This day commences the same steering N.W. under all sail (broke out water) at sundown took in the light sails steering the same. Mid part the same. Latter part the same made all sail.

353rd day

Mon. Feb. 21st 1870

This day commences the same steering to the N.W. at sundown took in the light sails. Mid part steering to the N.E. Latter part the same. turned out of the Boat on the house & painted it. employed in cleaning & painting the plates.
