

Remarks on Board 13th Globe

364th

Friday March 4th

This day commenced the same employed in overhauling & strapping blocks Mid part the same Latter part light breeze from the S. & E. steering to the S. & W. under all sail but fore top-g. sail made a pair of slings also made a long gunnys for breaking out oil & co. broke out Beef & Pork & Flour

365th

Sat. March 5th

This day commenced the same. saw porpoises at sundown took in the light sails & luffed to on the Port tack Mid part the same Latter part light breeze from the S. & E. steering W by S under all sail

366th

Sunday March 6th

This day commenced the same. broke out water at sundown took in the light sails double reefed & furlled the main sail Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the S. & E. steering W. S. & W. set the reef out & set the flying jib

367th

Mon March 7th

This day commenced the same. at sundown took in the light sails & double reefed Mid part light breeze from the S. & E. Latter part the same steering by the wind under all sail

368th

Tuesday March 8th

This day commenced the same broke out Flour (made a swab) at sundown took in the light sails Mid part double reefed & furlled the mainsail blowing strong with rain squally Latter part strong breeze from the S. & E. steering W by S set jib & spankers

369th

Wednesday March 9th

This day commenced the same set the main sail steering the same (employed in making scrub booms) at sundown furlled the main sail Mid part the same Latter part light breeze from the S. & E. steering to the N. & E. under all sail applied in a row back to the main sail

370th

Thursday March 10th

This day commenced the same. broke out Water (rainy) Mid part light breeze from the E. steering by the wind under all sail. Latter part nearly calm employed in scraping the mose off of the ship & painting buckets

371st

Friday March 11th

This day commenced with baffling breezes all sail set heading to the N. & E. cooper employed in making 2 buckets. made a bet with the cooper that I should not come a whaling again under 3 months after I got home from the voyage the bet was 10 dollars. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the East. cooper employed in making a bucket. Lat 22.27 Long 5.45

372nd

Saturday March 12th

This day commenced the same steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail made a new bunt gasket for the fore-top gallant sail at sundown set the fore-top g. sail. Mid part light breeze from the S. & E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Latter part the same employed in scraping down the masts & sailoring & co. painted the buckets over again Lat 22.57 Long 5.37 West
