

Bk Globe Off St. Helena

381st

Mon. March 21st/70

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind. At 10 o'clock reefed out. Saw two porpoises at sundown reefed the top sails. Mid night the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.E. steering down for the Land. At 1 o'clock reefed out. Broke out 1st & 2nd sail in sight.

382nd

Tues March 22nd/70

This day commences the same steering the same. At 10 o'clock lowered the main top-sail. At 3 o'clock lowered the main top-sail. Boat returned to the ship with a few letters (but none for me) at anchor here Bk. Briton & Ship Minerva Smith & Bk. Leonadia sailed from here to night. After the boat returned got up the chains & bent them on expect to come to an anchor in the morning. Mid part strong breeze from the S.E. working up to the North. At 10 o'clock end of the Island. Latter part strong breeze from the S.E. got the anchor of the Boat & hauled up more chain to the Starboard anchor. At 8 o'clock the Capt. came aboard and took the ship in to anchor. Furlled the sails.

383rd

Wednesday March 23rd

This day commences the same all hands employed in washing ship outside. Sent up the long jennants & got every thing in readiness for breaking out the oil. The Minerva Smith is to take at home for us. There is about 3 merchantmen here.

383rd

(Short Time) Wednesday March 23rd/70

This day commences the same. all hands employed in breaking out the oil. At 11 1/2 o'clock knocked off breaking out. & commenced filling & cooping the oil. broke out 35 casks there is 8 remaining in the hold. Tared down the fore stays & the back ropes, at 4 o'clock knocked off work.

384th

Thursday March 24th/70

This day all hands employed in Transshipping oil aboard of the Minerva Smith. (broke out the rest of the oil in the hold) Tared down the fore & aft stays to the main & Mizzen also served the fore-top Mast stay with dunnage. At 4 o'clock knocked off and washed off decks. The Bk. Ohio (Capt. Fenner) and President (Capt. Hmy) arrived in. The Bk. Osprey laying off & on.

385th

Friday March 25th

This day all hands employed in filling off the ground tier in the main hold & filling them with salt water. At 10 o'clock the Cape Horn Pigeon Capt. Harard arrived in with 300 bbls of oil. At 3 o'clock knocked off work. Put the flying jibstay over the mast head & the new fore royal rigging on served the fore-top Mast stay Tail jennants.

386th

Sat March 26th/70

This day commences the same all hands employed in breaking out shocks & filling them up for water. Bk. Desdemone arrived in Capt. Davis at 4 o'clock knocked off work.
