

Bk Globe off St. Helena.

421st

Sat April 30th/70

This day commence the same (cruising). Saw 5 sails made a net for the jaws of the fore-top-sail yard at 6.00 clock spoke the Bk Elton she had not seen any think since we saw her last at sundown double reefed & hauled up the main-sail Mid part fine weather parted from the Elton at 9.00 clock Latter part moderate breeze cruising Land about 8 miles distant. 7 sails in sight - middle sail.

422nd

Sun May 1st/70

This day commence the same 10 sails in sight - at sundown took in the light sails & double reefed Mid part the same. Latter part - strong trades set the reef out (cruising) 9 sails in sight.

423rd

Mon May 2nd/70

This day commence with moderate trades 10 sails seen this part - at sundown shortened sail as usual spoke the Bk Elizabeth - Mid part squally Latter part - strong trades accompanied with rain squalls, set the reef out & set main-sail flying jib & top sail made a leading board. Jib fore-rigging & beired it - In 7 sails in sight (with in light sails).

424th

Tues May 3rd/70

This day commence the same. Saw 3 sails. Caught some fish from along-side at sundown shortened sail as usual Mid part - strong trades. Latter part - the same 2 sails in sight.

Cruising: Wednesday May 4th/70

425th

This day commence with fresh trades set the reef out - saw 4 sails at sundown double reefed (cruising) No id part - blowing a light gale at 11.00 clock. Jib & spanker to put the Bow Boat on the upper plank broke the foreward Davit immediately rigged a tackle on it and secured it as well as possible and wore ship. Latter part - blowing a strong breeze from the S.E. saw 1 sail - employed in repairing the davit (broke out water) saw porpoise.

426th

Thursday May 5th/70

This day commence the same saw 4 sails Land about 15 miles distant No id part - the same Latter part - strong trades set the jib & spanker saw porpoise and 1 sail.

427th

Friday May 6th/70

This day begins the same. Broke out the cat at sundown took in the jib & spanker (squally this day) No id part - the same Latter part - the same sent down the fore-sail for repairs employed in repairing it (saw 2 sails) at 10.00 clock bent the sail.

428th

Sat May 7th/70

This day commence with strong trades, 3 sails in sight. There has been some trouble between the Mate and Capt. for some time past and the Capt. has tried to discharge him at St. Helena but the Mate refused to leave the ship without forcing and the Capt. did not seem to want to put him out by forcing there fore concluded to let him remain but since leaving
