St Helena the Capt. has heard of a great many ~~unpleasant~~ which came from the said person. Therefore the Capt. refused to him to know why he should repeat such lies, and he ~~denied~~ of saying anything against him which we all know to be a lie. He has also called the Capt. a great many undecent names during the voyage which all have been made known to the Capt. The Capt. asked him to give some reasons for such language, and he would not state any reasons whatever. The Capt. has told him that he had not proved satisfactory in any way during the voyage & he has come to the conclusion that he would put him ashore as all the Officers & others was unwilling to sail with him any longer he was just of duty to-day.

At sundown took in the jib & spanker. Mid part strong breeze at 3 o'clock kept off for the land. Latter part strong trades at 9 1/2 o'clock lowered the waist boat & took the Capt. ashore. The Boat returned to the ship after the (Mate. at 11 o'clock returned ashore with Mr Penney bag & baggage (he has taken for discharge.) Capt. gave order to take the ship in to an anchor one & 1/2 Monday Morning. Sailed from here. Bk Para of New Bedford Capt. Manton 11 months out with 260 bl.

Sunday May 8th / 70

This day commences the same. after the Boat came to the ship were ship standing off shore double reefed the top sails & the main sail. Mid part strong trades at 3 1/2 o'clock were ship heading in shore. Latter part the same. 3 sails in sight.

On board Bk Globe off St. Helena

430th day

Monday May 9th / 70

This day commences with a strong trades standing in shore under reefed courses jib & spanker 5 sails in sight. at 4 o'clock hauled up the Starboard cable & bent it. & got every thing in readiness for anchoring in the morning. Mid part strong trades. Latter part strong trades heading in for the anchorage under double reefed top sails fore sail jib & spanker. at 8 o'clock let go the Starboard anchor in 30 fathoms of water furlled the sails & got the hold ready for water. at 11 o'clock the water Boat came along side and commenced pumping water aboard.

437th day

Tuesday May 10th / 70

This day commences the same at 10 o'clock the water Boat left. took aboard 50 bl of water. at 2 o'clock took our anchor and put to sea under double reefed top sails fore sail jib & spanker. at 4 o'clock had the anchor & chain stowed. washed off decks. at 4 1/2 o'clock the Starboard Boat came on shore. after pumping potatoes carrots & leeks. got 2 doz. pumpkins and 8 or 9 bushels of potatoes. Boat returned at 5 1/2 o'clock. set the main sail. went up to the windward of the Harbor. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze. employed in breaking out the lumber for store to take ashore.

432nd day

Wednesday May 11th / 70

This day commences the same at 7 o'clock lowered the waist Boat and went ashore. at 4 o'clock the Boat returned and took off the dunnage.
