

Off St. Helena

and 8 bushels and 1. Dog, pumpkins
and 1 keg of Butter. also 2 fore-mast
hands and 2 Boat-stewards (by the
name of Samuel Williams) which
shipped there at St. Helena after
the Boat returned. Braced forward &
set the main sail. Standing off shore
2 sail in sight. Mr. Cogswell acting
as 6. Mate. Mid part. Not same boat
part-moderate breeze. Set all sail standing
off shore at 7 1/2 o'clock raised a school
of sperm whales to the windward of
the ship. at 9 o'clock lowered the
Barboard & Starboard & Boat Boat
and gave chase to the windward of the
ship after pulling to the windward for
about 3 miles. The ship made signals
for whale to the leeward immediately
kept off for the ship shortly after raised
the school and after maneuvering a short
time the Boat Boat succeeded in
striking a 40 bl whale the other 2
Boats striking the same whale shortly
after. At 4 33

Thursday May 12th

This day commenced the same at 3 o'clock the whale turned up took him
along at 4 o'clock and struck him
with a H. Brig in sight to the leeward a
whaling. after coming aboard. doubled reefed
the fore sails & furled the main sail &
light sails & broke out water bread &
flour & got every thing in readiness for
cutting (except sending up the tackle)
Mid part. laying aback with fine weather
 Latter part. moderate breeze at daylight
sent up the Backs and at 6 o'clock

Off St. Helena Boiling

3 sail hooked on to the whale at 9 o'clock had
him on on deck sent down the tackle
all hands employed in clearing away
the head. Braced forward heading on shore
Friday May 13th / 70

This day commenced with fine weather
set the reef out & set jib & gaff-top sail
at 3 o'clock had the deck cleared up
and washed off. saw several sails. (Chase
had his foot hurt by a spade) whilst
Land clearing away the head lost the gang-way
about 8 rail on board. cleared away the waist
miles Boat & brought it aboard. Mid part
distant moderate breeze laying off & on. Latter
part fine breeze at daylight started the
wakes boiling on the case. (or head). saw
several sail made all sail except main sail
4 33

Sat. May 14th / 70

This day commenced with a fine
breeze at 4 o'clock finished boiling the
head & commenced on the belly at
4 o'clock sent the waist & Boat
in shore after the Capt. at 3 o'clock
Boat returned with 5 iron that was
made ashore for humpbacking at 5 1/2
o'clock the Boat went ashore again
and returned again at 6 1/2 o'clock
the Capt. remaining ashore. saw porpoise.
(Chase & J. Johnson off duty) at
7 o'clock took in the light sails & dunnies
reefed the top sail the Capt. is expected
aboard next Tuesday. Mid part
boiling Latter part moderate breeze
at 6 o'clock finished boiling and put
on the stem & washed off the deck. saw
several sail also saw porpoise. set the main sail
flying jib & gaff-top sail.



Struck the whale about 11 o'clock. put my bed into the cabin

Price. went ashore in the Boat & came off ashore

the whale had changed up about 34
