

Remarks on Board Bk Globe Off St Helena

447th

Thursday May 26th/70

This day commences with a light breeze steering by the wind under all sail. 1 sail in sight. saw porpoises. spoke the Cape Horn Pigeon. & ascertained has out flour taken & cobbles since leaving St Helena at sundown took in the light sails. Mid part light breeze at 0 o'clock. parted from the Pigeon. Latter part moderate breeze steering by the wind under all sail. Land on the Starboard tack. employed in making having sprung 2 sails in sight.

448th

Friday May 27th/70

This day begins the same. Tacked ship. broke out clear and black fish oil. saw a number of fin backs also saw 2 sails. Mid part fine weather. Latter part nearly calm. all sail out. saw 3 whales also saw porpoises. sent in the flying jib & ripped it up. repaired the old jib and bent it in the place of the flying jib. spliced a shot of line on the spare lub of line. gave new flying jib sheets.

449th

Sat. May 28th/70

This begins the same 3 sails in sight. Mid part light breeze steering by the wind under all sail. Latter part the same 4 sails in sight sent down the fore-top sail employed in repairing it.

450th

Sun May 29th/70

This day begins with a light breeze heading to the S.E. under all sail. bent the fore-top sail. Mid part calm. Latter part calm nothing in sight.

Continued Remarks

451st

Mon. May 30th/70

This day begins with a calm nothing in sight (all sail out). Mid part calm. Latter part light breeze from the Westward steering S.E. by S. under all sail. watch employed in picking over potatoes. cooper & others employed in repairing an old water cask.

452nd

Tues. May 31st/70

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. spliced in the mizzen top mast-rigging rose new lanyards & set up the Starboard side watch employed in picking over corn (saw pump backs). Mid part light breeze. Latter part fresh trade steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. 1 sail in sight. took up the sealing of the Starboard Boat and painted the bottom on the inside. spliced in the Starboard mizzen top mast-rigging rose new lanyards & set it up. broke out Titou.

453rd

Wednesday June 1st/70

This day commences with fresh trade steering the same made a net-trap. saw a full rigged ship steering to the S.E. Mid part steering by the wind under all sail (except fore-top sail) on the Starboard tack. Latter part strong trade steering by the wind under all sail (except fore-top sail) on the Starboard tack. saw porpoises. watch employed in picking over corn. seized the spreaders on the mizzen top mast-rigging.
