454th

Thursday June 2nd/70
This day begins with fresh trades steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail (saw porpoise) at 3¹² o'clock took in the light-sail No id part - strong trade. Latter part the same took in the flying jib & gaff-top-sail

455th

Friday June 3rd/70
This day commences with strong trades steering by the wind under all sail (except the light-sails) on the Starboard tack saw a fin back. No id part the same Latter part strong trades steering by the wind took in the light-sails (broke out water)

456th

Sat. June 4th
This day commences the same nothing in sight. No id & Latter part fresh trades steering the same nothing in sight -
Long 2. 48. East Lat. 12. 30

457th

Sun. June 5th/70
This day begins with fresh trades steering by the wind under top sails course jib & spanker & gaff-top-sail No id part the same Latter part light-trades steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack saw porpoise

458th

Mon June 6th
This day begins with light trades steering the same. Struck a porpoise but the iron porpoise drew there fore lost him. No id part the same Latter part light breeze from the S & E ship heading S.E. under all sail saw porpoise

Broke out the Mizzen hold in order to stow over board. broke out the empty barrels and hoops them off also broke out a cask of Pork & a cask of Beef and found the head of the to be wanted out. (cooper put a new head into it) coopered the Bread casks Long 5. 48. East Lat. 11. 48

459th

Tuesday June 7th
This day begins with a light breeze from the S & E steering by the wind under all broke out sail on the Starboard tack. stowed off the meat - after hold. stowed 2 casks of Meat in the blubber room. Broke out Mollase & filled the tanks No id part the same Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. parted the Starboard jib gay sent it in and put out a new one. (got up the main rope. cooper employed in making tubs to carry cordage in the boats for hump Backing

460th

June Wednesday 8th
This day begins with a light air from the S & W steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. got up the main top-sail rigging No id part the same Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail broke out the run for Clamps covered the Carpenter's chest with canvas & painted it Long 7. 47. Lat. 11. 15

461th

Thursday June 9th/70
This day begins with a light breeze from the W. steering by the wind under all sail (nothing in sight) No id part the same Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering E. under all sail (went down the jib blocks & overhauled them
