

Remarks on Board Bk. Globe

Friday June 28th -

This day commence with light-breeze from the S. cruising up and down the Coast. Boat came aboard at 1. o'clock. at 4. o'clock raised a small whale, towed 3 Boats and gave chase at 5. o'clock the Mast Boat struck a small one and turned him up at sundown. at sundown anchored the Ship. & furled the lightsails. Wind part-fine weather after whale turned up the 3 Boats commenced towing for the Ship sent the Bow Boat to help tow at 8. o'clock had him along side & the fluke chain on. Latter part light breeze from the S. W. at day light sent up the tackle & got every thing in readiness for cutting after breakfast hooked on. had the whale cut in at 10. o'clock all hands employed in cutting up the flubber

Wednes June 29th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.W. discovered the Schooner's boat down a whaling immediately lowered the Bow Boat and gave chase. Shortly after the Starboard & Leeward Boats lowered chased the whaler until 3 o'clock & returned wth the ship without any whale. After coming aboard took off the caboose cover and fitted the works for working in the morning. Had part-fine weather. Leeward part-fine breeze from the S.W. started the work at day light. Captain Braly came aboard saw the Schooner lower 2 Boats.

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Done Thursday 30th -

This day commenced with a fine breeze from the S.W. at 2.0 o'clock raised whale lowered 3 Boats & gave chase shortly after the Waist-Boat struck a cow-whale & turned him up at 2 1/2 o'clock got the ship underweigh & stood off shore for the Boats at 5.0 o'clock came to anchor & took the whale along side & fluked him. The Bow Boat crew & the ship keepers employed in hauling at sundown (Captain Bracey came aboard) No air past fine weather at 11 1/2 o'clock finished hauling. Latter part fine breeze from the S.W. at 7.0 o'clock commenced cutting at 11 1/2 o'clock had the whale in.

Morit just boiling with fine weather. Start and wait first watch - below. Letter just light breeze washed off deck at 6 o'clock got underway & made all sail heading along shore (saw 4 whales
