

Remarks in Board Bk Globe

495th

July Wednesday 13th/70

This day commences with fine weather (boiling) at 12 1/2 o'clock raised in whale lowered 3 Boats & gave chase until 2 o'clock turned & returned to the ship. at 3 o'clock the Negro Boat left. at 5 o'clock finished boiling. turned up 48 bbls Mid part - fine weather. Latter part good weather at 10 o'clock raised whales lowered all 4 Boats & gave chase at 11 1/2 o'clock the Bow Boat struck a 45 bbl whale and after running off shore until 4 PM o'clock succeeded in killing him.

496th

July Thurs. 14th

This day commences the same at sunrise. The whale turned up. left 2 Boats with the whale & the other 2 started for the ship which was out of sight in shore. Latter part calm. cruised for the ship until 2 o'clock. & then gave up the ship for lost. & went aboard of the Brig Norma. where we were greeted with kindness. Latter part fine breeze from the S. & E. at 5 o'clock left the Brig and started for the Bark which was about 3 miles distant arrived aboard at 6 1/2 o'clock much fatigued after coming aboard got the ship under way & started for the whale at 10 o'clock took the whale along side at 11 o'clock commenced cutting in the whale.

497th

On the Coast of Africa

July Friday 15th/70

This day commences the same at 3 1/2 o'clock had the whale in. Saw 3 sails. Mid part good weather. Latter part the same at 6 1/2 o'clock started the work.

498th

July Sat. 16th

This day commences with fine weather (saw a merchant man) all hand employed in boiling. 2 Boats crew from the Bk Popray came aboard & brought us some sweet potatoes & a cake (Brig Norma in boiling) I have been to work at 2 o'clock have up anchor & made all sail standing in shore at 6 o'clock anchored. turned saw the Bk Popray at anchor. Mid part good weather (boiling) Port water first water in. finished boiling at 5 o'clock. Latter part good weather at 6 o'clock commenced blowing down in the fore hold.

499th

July Sun. 17th

This day begins with fine weather at 4 1/2 o'clock knocked off work have stowed down 67 bbls & 27 gallons saw the Popray Boat & whaling. Mid part the same. Latter part the same (saw a whale going quick) at 11 o'clock the Waist Starboard & Lardboard Boats left the ship on a cruise.

500th

July Mon 18th

This day begins with a light breeze at 3 1/2 o'clock lowered the Bow Boat for 2 whales. chased them until 5 o'clock & returned to the ship at sundown saw the Brig take a whale to day. Mid part fine weather. Latter part the same. The Lardboard & Starboard Boats left the ship for a cruise.
