Sat. July 23rd/70

This day commences with a calm

At sundown the Boats returned to the ship having seen nothing to day. Saw a Bark standing down the coast supposed to be the Ospray. Mid part - good weather. Latter part - the same at 7.0 clock the Mate & 2nd Mate left the ship for a day's cruise (coopered the oil).

Sun. July 24th

This day commences with a light breeze

At 1 1/2 o'clock discovered the Boat chasing the Capt. & gave chase until 4.0 clock and then gave up the chase. The Ospray took a small whale to day. At sundown the Boats returned to the ship. Mid part - the same. Latter part - fine breeze. At 6.0 clock the Starboard & Waist Boat left the ship on a day's cruise. At 7 1/2 o'clock raised a whale near the ship. Lowered the Bow Boat & gave chase at 11 1/2 o'clock struck him and turned him up shortly after. Ship got underway & stood for the whale. At 4 1/4 o'clock took him along side & commenced cutting. At sundown had him in on deck. Saw the Ospray take a whale.

Mon. July 25th/70

This day commences with a light breeze took the whale along side & commenced cutting. At sundown had him in on deck.

(The Capt. had his finger cut open) Mid part - the same. Latter part - fine breeze at 7.0 clock the Starboard & Waist Boats left the ship on a day's cruise. At 9.0 clock the Mate struck a large

Wump - Backing on the Coast of Africa whale. Lowered from the ship & started to assist him. I struck the whale 2nd Boat & lanced him some. At 11.0 clock the ship got underway & stood for the whale. At

Tues. July 26th

At 1 1/2 o'clock the whale turned up & left the Mate with the whale & came aboard. The other 2 Boats came aboard also at 3.0 clock arrived to the whale & anchored the ship near by (at 1 1/2 o'clock started the work). At sundown left Boat & 3 men to lay by the whale during the night. Mid part - boiling. Latter part - calm. Finished boiling at 7.0 clock after getting Breakfast commenced stowing down oil in the ground tier in the main hold (caught about a hundred fish).

Wednes. July 27th

This day commences with good weather finished stowing at 3.0 clock (stowed down 44. lbs) washed off deck. Filled the Mollasse tank in the after hold) broke out Flour at 5 1/2 o'clock went to the whale & tried to haul him up hauled 2 runs out & concluded to let him remain on the bottom. Left a Boat on by the whale to keep watch during the night. Mid part - the same. Latter part - light breeze at 7.0 clock hauled the whale up run the line to the ship & hauled the whale along side & commenced cutting in. At 11.0 clock had the whale in on deck. The Capt. & finger is no better.
