

Remarks On Board Bk Globe at Habenda

521st

Aug. Mon 8th/70

This day commences with a light breeze at 2.0 o'clock got underway made all sail and stood standing in shore under all sail at 6 1/2 o'clock came to an anchor close up the side of the Bk Triton is at anchor. Mid port the same. Lay in to anchor at Habenda latter part fresh breeze Captain & a Boat's crew for ashore. ^{Edward Perry went ashore in the Boat & described the ship}

522nd

Aug. Tues 9th/70

This day commences the same lay in to anchor at Habenda Mid port the same latter part light air at 9.0 o'clock made all sail took the anchor & lowered 3 Boats & moved the ship off shore got about 11.00 oranges here at Habenda & a few peanuts also a few sweet potatoes

523rd

Aug Wednesday 10th/70

This day commences with a light breeze steering down the Coast under all sail raised whale lowered the quarter Boat & chased them until 4.00 o'clock & returned to the ship the Triton in company with us saw them two for whales (copied the oil to day) divided the oranges among the crew. Mid port fine weather at 7.0 o'clock came to anchor latter part light breeze from the Southward at 6 1/2 o'clock got underway standing down the Coast under all sail all hands employed in stowing down oil in the main hold

524th

Aug Thursday 11th/70

This day with a fresh breeze from the N. lowered the Starboard Boat for hump back & caught none at 3.0 o'clock finished stowing oil this makes us 425. bbls of hump back oil

1870

From Habenda down the Coast saw the Triton lower for whales. Saw a number of fin backs to day at 4.0 o'clock passed Black Point heading in shore to anchor saw a whale at anchor in shore the Bk Triton is in company with us at sun down spoke the Bk Wave of New Bedford Captain Briggs 14 months out with 6.40. bbls of oil anchored near by the Wave & the Triton also. Captain Briggs & Sull came aboard Mid port fine weather latter part light breeze at 7.0 o'clock washed off at 7 1/2 o'clock got underway standing down the Coast under all sail the Triton also saw the Triton take 2 whales Cooper employed in repairing casks

525th

Aug Friday 12th

This day commences the same (broke out Port at 3.0 o'clock raised whale lowered 3 Boats & gave chase until sundown & returned with no whale at sundown came to anchor Mid port the same latter part light breeze at 6 1/2 o'clock the Starboard & Waist Boat left the ship on a stage cruise at 9.0 o'clock the Starboard Boat struck a 25 bbl whale the Waist Boat pulled to the fast Boat & passed their iron to the fast Boat & the 2nd Mate struck another whale which was a running with the other whale lowered the other 2 Boats to assist the fast Boat at 10 1/2 o'clock the whale turned up touched them.
