

Remarks on Board Bk. Globe

530th

Wednesday Aug. 17th/70

This day commenced with a light breeze employed in boiling. Mid part light breeze (boiling). Latter part nearly calm. Saw Bk. Nautilus of New Bedford Capt. Smith 70 months out with 3500 lbs of whale oil employed in boiling & repairing casks &c

531st

Thursday Aug. 18th

This day commenced the same as - turned 2 1/2 o'clock finished boiling. Capt. went up 52nd ft. aboard of the Nautilus & got some Mollusc & Larva. at 1 o'clock raised a whale near the ship lowered the Bow Boat & struck him at 3 o'clock turned the whale up & commenced turning him in shore. The ship got underway & stood for the Mid part squally. at 9 o'clock got the whale along side & fluked. The ship anchored at 8 1/2 o'clock when I lowered from the ship my Boat-stove was absent (gunning) therefore I took John S. Logan. Latter part fine weather hooked on to the whale at 7 o'clock & at 10 o'clock had him on on deck.

532nd

Friday Aug. 19th

This day commenced with a light breeze after dinner commenced stowing down in the fore hold at 5 o'clock left off stowing & cooped some of the oil on deck. finished stowing in the ground tier casks (are all full) at ten down started the works. Mid part boiling. Latter part fine weather. one watch employed in boiling. Starboard watch below at 11 o'clock got underway. made all sail & stood in shore.

On the Coast of Africa Hump Backing

533rd

Sat. Aug. 20th/70

This day commenced with a light breeze at 3 o'clock came to anchor in 12 fathoms of water. (saw the Nautilus & Boiling) took the Mast out of a cask and put it into barrels up 30th ft in order to have the cask for oil. Mid part (boiling) Latter part fine weather finished boiling at 7 o'clock & commenced stowing down oil in the main hold. saw 2 whales (Bk. Nautilus is a boiling)

534th

Sun. Aug. 21st/70

And This day commenced the same at 6 o'clock knocked off work. filled the main hold on the Port side. Mid part fine weather. (Oh dear me I feel rather weary this night) Latter part fine weather all hands engaged in stowing down at 11 o'clock finished stowing & washed off decks.

535th

Mon. Aug. 22nd/70

This day commenced the same at 2 o'clock raised a whale. immediately lowered & Boat and gave chase. at 5 o'clock Boat returned without success. at sundown came to anchor. Mid part the same. Latter part fine weather. at 6 1/2 o'clock got underway and stood down the coast under all sail. have been at work to-day trying to stop the try pots from leaking by applying charcoal salt & vinegar.

536th

Tues. Aug. 23rd/70

This day commenced with a light breeze heading down the Coast under all sail at 3 o'clock lowered the Bow Boat to take the Capt. aboard of the Triton. and from the Triton went aboard of the Nautilus which was lying here to anchor.
