

Remarks on Board B^k Globe

Mid part moderate weather Latter part good weather employed in carpentering &c
at 8 1/2 o'clock got underway. In case of sail heading down

537th

Wednesday Aug 24th /70

This day begins with a light breeze from the S & E. at 8 1/2 o'clock took the anchor & made all sail steering down the coast. Broke on heading N. N. W. Saw no whale but several Reef & Pink diamond fish. at sundown came to anchor in 17 fathoms of water. Mid part fine weather. Latter part calm at 3 o'clock

got the Ball 4 Boats left the ship on a days cruise at 7 o'clock. The Bow Boat struck a calf there was a cow with the calf. I took the 2nd Mate iron from his Boat & struck the cow. at 12 o'clock the whale turned up (cut off from the calf and let him go.) the cow sunk immediately. at 1 o'clock the ship came to anchor by the whale. at 2 o'clock the Bow & Starboard Boats left the ship for more whales. at 6 o'clock the Mate struck a large cow and the Waist Boat pulled up and struck 2nd Boat and the whale struck the Boat & drove her badly knocking the 3rd Mate over board the same time

Thursday Aug 25th

This day commences the same as the line above the whale struck the Boat & several times cutting her completely into and killed Ezekiel Leeb of St Helena also wounded Frank. I took the Mate picked up the crew & stored Boat & cut from the whale & started for the ship hooked on all 3 Boats & towed the Boat to the ship wound to the

By the Starboard Boat from off the house & put the mast on the Waist Boat & put the Mast on the Bow Boat

539th

On the Coast of Africa

Ship at 8 o'clock with a bad heavy one of our number has gone to his long home. (lost the Motion Boat on deck.) Took the Triton Boats struck a whale to day also the Nautilus. Mid part fine breeze Latter part the same at 8 o'clock the 3 Boats left the ship on a days cruise Mr Riley & his Boat crew employed in making a new Boatsail & getting one of the old Boats out from off the house

Friday Aug 26th /70

This day commences with a light breeze (I had a whale missed to day) at 2 o'clock the Waist Boat lowered for whales laying which came near the ship but did not strike any. at 4 1/2 o'clock Boats came aboard. B^k Nautilus & Triton in light Mid part fresh breeze Latter part the same lowered the Starboard Boat & tried to haul the whale up but could not start him with the Boat therefore took the Mr Riley line to the ship & managed to haul him employed up at 9 o'clock found that the sharks had eat all the blubber but about 20 lbs of meat hauled him along side & cut it in

540th

Sat Aug 27th /70

This day commences with a fresh breeze Starboard Boat started the work at 2 o'clock at 9 1/2 o'clock lowered the Waist Boat & gave chase the first for whale but returned without success (saw the Nautilus a sailing) Mid part (sailing) Latter part light breeze at 8 o'clock lowered the Bow & Starboard Boats & started on a days cruise saw the Nautilus & Boats a cruising & started the Boat
