

On Board B^k Globe from the Coast-

546th

Sept. Friday 2nd /70

This day commence with a light breeze from the S & W steering by the wind under all sail broke out the ship's cask & supplied the men with clothing. at 4.0 - clock. Waked off the ship. Mid part light breeze from the S & W steering by the wind. Lacked ship 4 times during the night. Latter part light breeze from the S & W at 8.0 - clock raised the land of Anabona leaving W. at 9.0 - clock broke out the rain for water to supply the crew with at 11.0 - clock raised a school of Black fish lowered the Starboard Trawl & Lardboard Boat & caught 1 to the Trawl and 1 to the Lardboard Boat & 2 to the Starboard Boat Land Ho

547th

Sept. Sat 3rd 1870

This day commence the same at 1 1/2 - 0 clock took the fish in on deck. all hands employed in clearing away the Black fish salted 4. bbls of fish. Crew to trade with the natives at Anabona. at sundown the land bore. W & W 75. mile distant. Mid part beating up for the land. Latter part light breeze from the S & W working up for the land missed the Black fish. Blubber

548th

Sept. Sunday 4th /70

This day commence the same ran a sail in shore. Mid part light breeze beating for the land under all sail. Latter part fine breeze from the S & W at 11.0 - clock came to anchor & furlled the sails. The natives are very fierce for trade

of Anabona. September 2nd 1870

549th

Sept. Mon 3rd /70

This day commence with a light breeze from the S & W. Lay on to anchor. Arrived at Anabona at 11.0 - clock. Started up 6. bbls the work sailing on the Black fish. Blubber. Lowered 3 Boats for a Pump. Back but caught him not. at sundown finished brought boiling. Mid part the same. Latter part off 3. fresh breeze from the S & W at day light 3 Boats left the ship on a day cruise to the windward of end of the Island. men aboard employed in getting wood & string it away. Capt. ashore trading for wood &c.

550th

Sept. Tues 6th

This day commence the same. hands aboard employed in getting wood. Traded some of the Black fish meat for Bananas. Sweet Potatoes. Brown stuff & on at 3 1/2 - 0 - clock. Boats returned having seen several whales. The Lardboard Boat went along side of a calf & the Boat steered past 1 bison at the calf & a lance at the cow. which was with the calf. did not fasten to the calf. supposed that the iron point of his harpoon. Mid part fine weather. Latter part fresh breeze from the S & W. 3 Boats left the ship at 6.0 - clock on a day cruise. Capt. ashore trading for potatoes &c. took aboard about 25 bushels of sweet potatoes (set up the potato gun)

551th

Sept. Wednes 7th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S & W. took aboard 25 bushels of sweet potatoes. at sundown the Boats returned with a canoe to the ship without success. Mid part the same. Latter part the same. at 7.0 - clock. All 4 Boats left the ship on a day cruise
