

On Board B^t Globe at Anabona

532nd

Sept. Thursday 8th/70

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S.W. at sundown the Boat returned to the ship having seen a few whales all over acting shy & wild. Mid part the same. Latter part strong breeze from the S.W. at 7 1/2 o'clock the Waist Starboard & Bow Boats left the ship on a days cruise. The Starboard Boat did not lower as Mr Coggeshall has a tail under his arm. At 9 o'clock the Waist Boat struck a calf but drew from him shortly after.

533rd

Sept. Friday 9th/70

This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S.W. at sundown from the Boat returned to the ship having chased several whales during the day but they were going quick & acted very wild. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze at 7 1/2 o'clock 3 Boats left the ship on a days cruise to the windward of the Island at 10 o'clock the Bow Boat struck a cow whale & the whale started off shore running very fast. After running off shore for about 5 miles engaged to strike the calf & dragged him.

534th

Sept. Sat 10th/70

This day commenced the same at 3 1/2 o'clock turned the wheel up & commenced towing for the ship. The Starboard Boat came from the ship to help us tow the whale. Mid part light breeze from the S.W. at 7 1/2 o'clock got the whale along side. Latter part cut him in.

At Anabona

535th

Sept. Sun. 11th/70

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S.W. at 1 1/2 o'clock had the whale on on deck the schooner the one very busy in cutting the meat from the carcass at 4 o'clock started the work 1 man off duty with a cut leg. (Mr Riley has the last up with a lame shoulder) at 6 o'clock the waist Mid part sailing. Latter part the same Capt. of the Brig came aboard I have wrote a letter to send by this Brig.

536th

Sept. Mon 12th/70

This day commence with a light breeze from the S.W. employed in boiling. (1 watch below.) Mid part boiling. Latter part light breeze at 7 o'clock the Starboard Starboard & Waist Boats left the ship on a days cruise. Bow Boat crew employed in boiling. at 10 o'clock the Starboard Boat came back to the ship having been stove by collision of the Waist Boat. Cooper employed in repairing the Boat.

John Coggeshall was not in his boat to day he having the Boat with him in the harbor.

537th

Sept. Tues 13th

This day commenced the same I lowered for a cow & calf which came near the ship chased some ways & returned to the ship. (at 5 o'clock finished Boiling) and cleared up the deck. At sundown Boats returned. Mid part fine weather. Latter part strong breeze from the S.W. at 8 o'clock all 4 Boats left the ship on a days cruise. The Brig Clifton sailed.

Turner 16 & 17 of oil
