

Remarks on Board B^o Globe at Anabona

558th

Sept. Wednes 14th

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S.W. at 2.0 o'clock. The Bow Boat struck a calf and the Starboard Boat struck the Cow. The lines got across & cut the lines off. I landed the calf which I suppose killed him. Therefore the Cow, cleared out. At sundown Boats returned to the ship with fish & many luck. Mid part - The same. Latter part fine weather at 7.0 o'clock commenced stowing down oil in the main hold.

559th

Sept. Thursday 15th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.W. at 3.0 o'clock finished stowing down & lifted some casks for rafting for water. Mid part - The same. Latter part fine weather at 8.0 o'clock the quarter Boats left the ship on a day's cruise. Men aboard employed in getting water. At 12.0 o'clock towed the raft along side & hoisted it on deck.

560th

Sept. Friday 16th

This day commences the same employed in stowing water in the fore hold stowed about 60 bbls at 5¹/₂ o'clock sent the raft ashore to be filled again. At sundown the Boats from whaling came aboard say a Whaling Boat working up to the Island & another sail to light. Mid part fine weather Bk Naulitus arrived in Latter part light breeze from the S.W. 2 Boats left the ship on a day's cruise. towed the raft along side & hoisted it on. Bk Triton arrived in

561st

Sept. Sat. 17th

This day commences the same. At sundown Boats came aboard without success. Mid part fine weather. Latter part the same broke out the Board between decks & covered it stowed in back & stowed water between decks also. Washed off the outside of the ship. brought off one Boat load of wood.

562nd

Sept. Sun. 18th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.W. brought off a load of wood & stowed it below. Mid part the same. Latter part fine weather.

563rd

Sept. Mon. 19th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.W. some of the crew ashore on a run. Mid part the same. Latter part fine weather. Bk Naulitus sailed. Washed off the inside of the ship as far as the water brought off about 12 bushels of potatoes & several bunches of Bananas sent down & stowed away the cutting tackle put the Starboard anchor on the Bow. ~~At 10 o'clock the same~~ ~~the same~~ part fresh breeze at 9.0 o'clock took the anchor stowed out to sea on the Starboard tack under all sail. Farewell to Anabona. Day stowed the chains & lashed the anchor.

Sept. Wednesday 21st

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. ship heading by the wind on the Starboard tack. employed in caulking gun lines & fitting whaling gear. At Mid part strong by the wind started ship at 5.20 o'clock.
