Sept. Sun. 25th 70

W & N coiled 2 shots of air into the Waist
Boils but Mid part changeable winds
ship on different tacks during the night
Leather part light breeze from the S & W
steering by the wind under all sail
on the Port tack had a few rain squalls
Lat. 4.37 S Long 7.34 East

from the S & W ship on different tacks. Mid

saw 1 sail (broke out Beef) watch
employed in making spungum &
scrapping down mask
