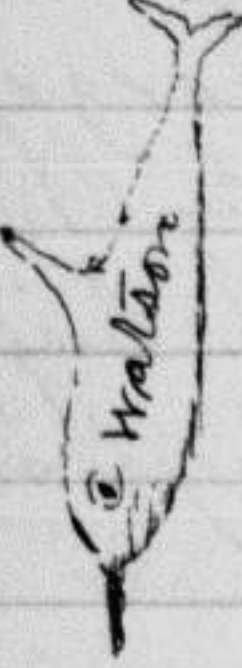


Remarks on Board Bth Ship from Amaloma

584th


Mon. October 10th/70

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the S & E steering S.W. took in the main-top gallant sail. Caught a porpoise Mid part steering S.W. under all sail except top of sail with strong trade. Latter part the same ^{with in the flying jib} ~~with in the flying jib~~
 Lat. 15.25 South - Long. 00. 58.7W

585th

Tues. October 11th/70

This day commences with strong trade steering W.S.W. Mid part moderate breeze steering the same Latter part steering W by S under all sail washed down the main mast Lat 14.55. Long 2.42. West-

586th

Wednesday October 12th/70

This day commences with strong trade steering W. by S. under all sail Mid & Latter part steering to the West under all sail Latter part broke our Water keel & Flour.

587th

Thursday October 13th/70

This day commences with a fresh breeze steering W. N.W. under all sail (at 12 o'clock Latitude was 15.36 South) at 3.0 o'clock Longitude raised the land bearing W. by N. the distance of 30 miles. hauled up cables & bent them on Daws & sail. Mid part strong trade at 9.0 o'clock double reefed the top sails & shifted to on the Port tack were ship at 12.2 o'clock. Latter part strong trade at 6.0 o'clock got the anchors off of the Bow & hauled up the cable for the reefs out of the top sails & went in to anchor at 10.0 o'clock. came to anchor furlled the sail & washed off the outside of the ship

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588th

Friday October 14th 1870

This day commences the same lying to anchor for St. Helena. I have received 6 letters this day from home at anchor here Bth Sautter Leonigae President (Army) Desdemone Tilton & Brig Meyra. Arrived to day American Frigate Delaware. Mid part fine weather Latter part squally

589th

Sat. October 15th/70

This day commences the same turned the Boat over & Bricked them off and got them in readiness for painting. I have sent 4 letters to New York & day by the frigate Delaware. Mid part fine weather Latter part fine weather painted the Boat & cleared the Bay works off making preparation for taking out the broken Pot. have bought a Pot of the Bth President. Mid part

590th

Sunday October 16th

This day commences the same. Mid part fine weather Latter part the same & watch ashore.

591th

Mon. Oct- 17th/70

This day began with fine weather. Mid part the same Latter part employed in painting the Boat got a Bay Pot from the Bth President

592th

Tuesday October 18th/70

This day commences the same Mid part fine weather Latter part fresh breeze employed in setting up the head stays also set up the fore top mast & top gallant tack stays. Sold a lot of clothing Port & shore by go aboard of the Bth & Bth of New London
