

Remarks on Board Bk. Globe

631st

Sat. Nov 26th /70

This day begins with a fresh breeze from the N.E. Steering by the wind under top sails & courses. Boats employed in making Boat Buckets at sundown took in the main sail & double reefed. Mid part squally with rain. Wind hauled to the S.W. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. ship heading S.E. under all sail (except top of sails)

632nd

Sun. Nov. 27th /70

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. ship heading S by E. (Broke out water) at sundown took in the light sails double reefed and furled the mainsail. Mid part wind light & changeable with ship as 10 o'clock. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind on the port tack. For the reef out and set up sail flying jib & Surinen topmast. Jib sail saw from back & jammers. Lat. 37.36 Long 9.03 W

633rd

Monday Nov. 28th

This day begins with a light breeze from the S.W. steering the same. Set main top gallant sail. At sundown shortened sail as usual. Mid part calm. Latter part strong breeze set the reef out & set the main sail. Painted Leadboard overhead Boat-

634th

Tues Nov. 29th /70

This day commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. at 12 o'clock took in the light sails & double reefed the top sails. At sundown furled the main sail jib & spanker also took in the fore top sail. Mid part the same with ship as 12 o'clock. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. set fire top sail jib & spanker steering by the same

Wednesday Nov. 30th

This day commences with a light breeze from S.W. steering by the wind under double reefed top sails fore sail jib & spanker. Broke at sundown fine weather. Mid part calm. Latter part light breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Broad Port tack

636th

Thursday Dec. 1st

This day commences the same at sundown shortened sail as usual. Mid part steering S by W. with a light breeze from E by S. Latter part the same made all sail painted the Boat on the House

637th

Friday Dec. 2nd

This day begins the same with a light breeze from the N.E. steering S by W. under all sail at sundown shortened sail as usual & luffed to on the Port tack. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the North steering S by W. set jib & spanker

638th

Sat. Dec 3rd /70

This day begins with a fresh breeze from the North steering S under the same sail. Saw grampuses at 3 o'clock luffed to on the Port tack. Had a few rain squalls. Mid part the same. Latter part set in thick & calm with a fresh breeze from the N.E. took in fore top sail

639th

Sunday Dec 4th /70

This day commences the same at 6 o'clock. The rain ceased. Manned the mast head. Mid part the same. Latter part fine weather. Made all sail steering
