

Continued Remarks on Board B³
Thursday Dec 13th/70

648th day
This day commence with a light breeze from the N.N.W ship heading W under all sail saw Fin back & Porpoise at sundown took in sail as usual Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the Westward with a thick fog (saw a fin back) set the jib & spanker and set the reef out steering by the wind on the Starboard tack set main top sail.

649th day
Wednesday Dec 14th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the W.N.W steering the same. Saw 1 sail heading to the S.E. at sundown shortened sail as usual Mid part moderate weather Latter part the same made all sail steering S.E. by E. wind from the N.W.

650th day
Thursday Dec 15th

This day commence the same at sundown shortened sail as usual & luffed to on the Port tack heading S.E. by E. Mid part the same Latter part light breeze from the N.W steering S.E. under all sail broke out Mollases.

651st day
Friday Dec 16th/70

This day commence with a light breeze from the N.W steering S.E. at 6 o'clock set in rainy shortened sail to double reefed top-grammesail & fore sail and luffed to on the Port tack. Mid part the same Latter part moderate weather made all sail.

652nd day
Sat. Dec 17th

This day commence the same at sundown shortened sail Mid heading W.N.W. on the Starboard tack Latter part fresh breeze from the N.W made all sail steering by the wind on the S. tack.

653rd day
Sunday Dec 18th/70

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the Northward steering by the wind under all sail at 2 o'clock took in main top-grammesail. Saw jumper at sundown shortened sail as usual Mid part squally Latter part strong breeze from the N.N.W took in the fore top-grammesail. Saw ship at 5 1/2 o'clock at 8 o'clock commenced to moderate set the reef out set the main sail jib & spanker & set top sail.

654th day
Mon Dec 19th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the N.N.W steering by the wind on the Port tack at sundown shortened sail as usual Mid part light breeze Latter part strong breeze from the S.W set the main sail jib & spanker steering N.E. by N.

655th day
Tuesday Dec 20th/70

This day commence with a strong breeze from the S.W steering N.E. by N. Saw 1 sail Mid part steering the same set the reef out of the main top sail Latter part moderate breeze from the S.W steering N.E. under all sail.

656th day
Wednesday Dec 21st

This day commence the same Mid Latter part steering N.E. with a light breeze from the S.W made a new Smoker pipe.

657th day
Thurs Dec 22nd/70

This day commence the same Mid part calm Latter part light breeze from the E.N.E. steering by the wind on the S. tack.
